

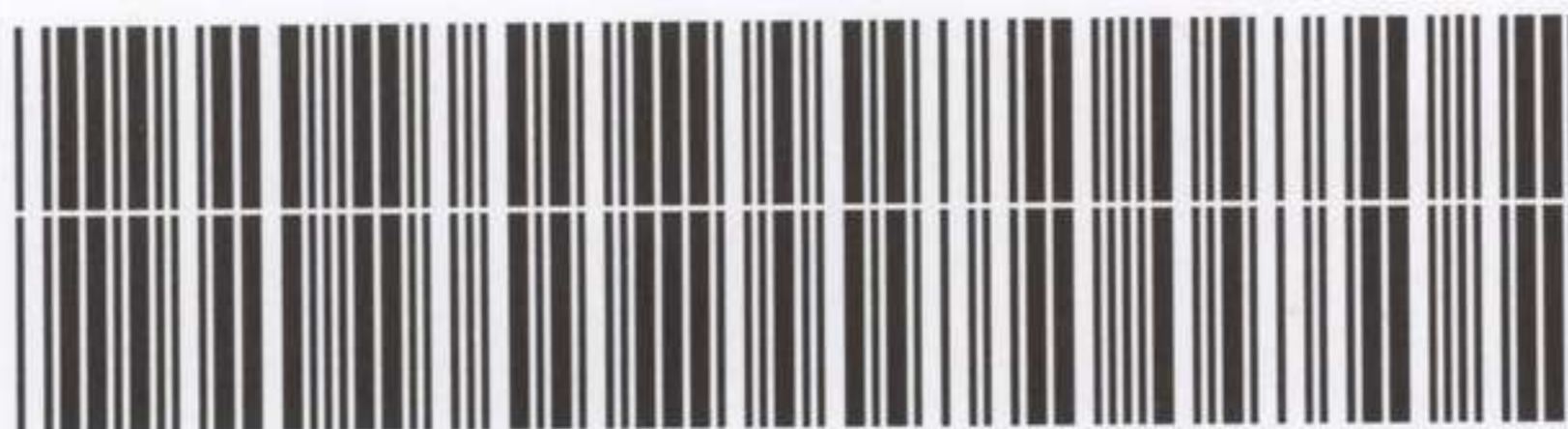

SERAPEUM	MAY 1	15	Were inspected by Lt. Genl. GODLEY, Army Corps Commander.	
		2/5	Company carried on with training in Company Drill, Ceremonial Drill, Rafts & Light Bridges, Loopholes, Breastworks, service conditions on Flat Country under fire, Sapping, Trustle Bridging etc etc. Lectures given by Capt COLYER each day.	
		6	No 4 Sect under Lt POTTS, specially prepared & equipped to be in readiness to move out at half hours notice, if need arose.	
		7	Sunday. Church parade held by Lt Col ELLIOTT, C.D.E.	
		8/13	Company engaged on Demolitions (several kinds): making of emergency bombs; Weldon Trustles Mining & Sapping etc.	
		14	Sunday. Church parade held by C.D.E.	
		15/20	Took over working of the Pontoon Bridge & also running of, & repairs to, the Light Railway. 22 men were detailed for the bridge & 6 for mechanical duties on the Railway, remainder of company on Training in various engineer works.	
		21	Sunday. Held Rifle & Kit inspection parade & noted any deficiencies which were made good where possible.	
		22/29	Company, by sections, underwent Musketry course. Whilst not engaged on Musketry continued training. Undertook & finished repairs to Pontoon Bridge. Returned all Mules & Draught Horses to SUEZ. Divisional Review by Commander in Chief.	
		30	Relieved of all works by 2/1 st Welsh Field Coy RE	
		31	Preparations for move
