ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM No. 153

With reference to G. 107 ; the following will be the Administrative instructions for the move to "M" Area.

and 20th. A.A.S.C.

1. The Division less Artillery will move to "M" Area complete with personnel and equipment ; no personnel or kit or equipment of any kind being left in the SENLIS Area.

2. Quarters

The Division will be quartered in "M" Area in accordance with Table "A" attached. Advance parties will be sent 24 hours ahead of troops to take over camps. They will give a receipt for tents etc., taken over - and Units will forward a statement of the tentage etc., taken over to Divisional Headquarters by noon on 18th instant.

Rear parties will be left to hand over billets to Town Majors or incoming troops and the usual certificates obtained that billets were left in a clean condition.

3. Ammunition

Units will move with full mobile echelons of bombs and S.A.A.

4. Rail Arrangements

(a) Detailed arrangements for the move of personnel by rail will be issued later -

9. Baths.

Div. Baths Officer will arrange for baths at SENLIS WARLOY and RUBEMPRE to be handed over to 5th. Aust. Div. and baths at N.11.a.7.9. and BAPAUME to be taken over from them. Personnel at BOUZINCOURT baths will be left for the use of Div. Artillery. The Foden disinfectant will move to the baths at N.11.a.7.9. on 16th instant.

10. Sanitation.

Units will see that all billets are left in a clean condition and that no food or kit is left behind ; all billets will be inspected after troops move out and a party left behind so as to ensure that the cleaning up is completed.

Particular attention will be paid to sanitation in the new Area. Latrines and incinerators will be established and kept in proper order and steps taken to prevent old trenches or shell holes being used as latrines or rubbish tips.

All manure from horse lines will be close packed in accordance with instructions already issued.

11. Water Pts.

(a) The AMIENS picquet will be withdrawn on night of 13th instant ; lorries to convey personnel back to their units will report at A.P.M.s office AMIENS at 11 p.m. on that evening.

(b) Picquets supplied by 5th. and 7th Brigades at PUCHEVILLERS and VARRENNES stations will entrain there with their Brigades.

(c) The 5th. A.I.Bde. will detail a guard of 1 Sergeant 1 Corporal and 6 men to remain at D.H.Q.

ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM No. 154.

With reference to Second Australian Divisional Order No. 132, para 4 (a) and Administrative Memo No. 155 para 4 (a): the following are the arrangements for the move of personnel of the Division by rail from SENLIS Area to BAPAUME :-

1. Table "A" is the time table for the trains in which personnel will entrain in accordance with Table "B".
2. Each train will consist of 2 officers' coaches, 35 covered trucks and one brake van.
3. No personnel or stores will be allowed in the brake vans or on the roofs of the trucks.
4. Personnel only will be entrained. No baggage stores or vehicles will be put on board.
5. Units will be at the entraining station one hour before the departure time of the train. No troops will enter the station yard until the R.T.O. indicates that he is ready for them.
6. Troops will be marched off the detraining station and the area cleared without delay.
7. Entraining and detraining officers will be detailed as follows :-

14th. instant	-----	5th. Aust. Inf. Brigade
15th. instant	-----	6th. Aust. Inf. Brigade
17th. instant	-----	7th. Aust. Inf. Brigade
18th. instant	-----	2nd. Aust. Pioneer Bn.

The entraining officer will report to the R.T.O. one and half hours before the departure of the first train. He will remain until the last train is loaded and proceed in it to BAPAUME. The detraining officer will proceed to BAPAUME in the first train, report to the R.T.O. there immediately on arrival and remain at the station until the troops from the last train have left the yard.

8. Each Unit will send an officer ahead to report to the Entraining Officer with a state showing the exact number of men to be entrained so that the train accommodation can be properly allotted.
9. Strict discipline will be maintained at the entraining and detraining stations and en route: the necessary picquets will be detailed to maintain order and prevent troops straggling or leaving the train.
10. The 5th. Australian Infantry Brigade will detail a guard of one N.C.O. and 8 men to mount over the ammunition depot at PUCHEVILLERS Station at 7 a.m. on 14th. June: the guard will remain on until immediately prior to the departure of the last train/ when it will be taken off and entrain. from that station,

ADMINISTRATIVE MEMO No. 15B

The following will be the administrative arrangements for "M" Area.

Administration. Brigades will be responsible for the administration of the following areas (particularly the supervision of SANITATION and WATER) :-

5th. Australian Infantry Brigade. - A Brigade Area

The N. corner of "M" Area bounded on S.E. by BAPAUME-CAMBRAI Road and on S.W. by AVESNES-BIHUCOURT Road.

6th. Australian Infantry Brigade - B Brigade Area .

E. corner of M Area bounded on N. by BANCOURT-BAPAUME Road and on S.W. by BAPAUME-PERONNE Road.

7th. Australian Infantry Brigade - C Brigade Area.

Centre of M Area bounded on N.W. and N. by AMIENS-BAPAUME-CAMBRAI Road and on E. by BANCOURT-BAPAUME and BAPAUME-PERONNE Road.

Sanitation.

- (a) Latrines - Proper latrine accommodation must be provided in every camp and kept in proper order. Old trenches and shell holes, are not to be used as latrines, and disciplinary action is to be taken against all offenders.
- (b) Rubbish is not to be left about or thrown into shell holes or old trenches, but destroyed in incinerators which are to be established in every camp.
- (c) Camps are to be kept clean - in particular each camp is to have a proper ablution place - indiscriminate washing soon soils the whole camp.
- (d) Horse lines are to be kept clean of manure which is to be removed daily and close packed.

Water.

- (a) Water for drinking and cooking is only to be drawn from water points or wells tested and found fit for use. It is to be drawn in either water carts or petrol tins and at once treated with the amount of bleaching powder laid down; one of the Medical details attached to the unit is to supervise the drawing of the water and attend to the CHLORINATION of it, and the Medical Officer will exercise a constant supervision.
- (b) Brigades will supervise the watering of horses at the water points in their areas and prepare and issue Time Tables to all units using the water point to avoid congestion at the troughs or on the roads near by.

Horses going to and returning from water are not to use main roads but side tracks.

Men are to unbit and loosen girths outside the enclosures at the water points and lead their horses to the troughs.

Each Brigade will detail an officer and the necessary picquets to supervise watering and see that units adhere to time tables and observe the above instructions.

4. Salvage.

Brigades will arrange for the collection of any salvage in their Brigade areas at dumps which they will establish at their Brigade ration dumps, and the empty ration transport will load salvage there and deposit it at the salvage dump at Railhead.

5. Canteens.

The Divisional Canteen is established on the PERONNE L. at N.5.c.3.1. There is an E.F.Canteen in AVESNES les BAPAUME.

6. Baths.

There are baths at SUCRERIE BAPAUME H.27.a.8.1. (No.1) and N.11.a.7.9. (No.2).

No. 1 Baths are allotted for the ensuing week to 5th. Australian Infantry Brigade, 6th. Australian Infantry Brigade and 7th. Australian Infantry Brigade, and Divisional troops will use No. 2 baths arranging times direct with Divisional Baths Officer at D.H.Q.

Personnel proceeding by the above trains should report to the R.T.O. one hour before departure of the train.

As leave personnel and personnel for schools will proceed direct from their unit - the unit must make its own arrangements for the men to be bathed and properly equipped prior to their departure.

All such personnel will be inspected by an officer immediately before they proceed to the station and issued with the necessary certificates that their equipment is complete and that they are free from vermin and scabies. (Ad.Memo.93 para 3 (a) and D.R.O. 1412).
