

ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM No. 154.

With reference to Second Australian Divisional Order No. 132, para 4 (a) and Administrative Momo No. 155 para 4 (a): the following are the arrangements for the move of personnel of the Division by rail from SENLIS Area to BAPAUME :-

- Table "A" is the time table for the trains in which 1. personnel will entrain in accordance with Table "B".
- Each train will consist of 2 officers' ceaches, 35 2. covered trucks and one brake van.
- No personnel or stores will be allowed in the brake vans 3. or on the roofs of the trucks.
- Personnel only will be entrained. No baggage stores or vehicles put on board.
- Units will be at the entraining station one hour before 5. the departure time of the train. No troops will enter the staller yard until the R.T.O. indicates that he is ready tor them.
- Troops will be marched off the detraining station and 6. the down cleared without delay.
- Entraining and detraining officers will be detailed as 7. follows :-

---- 5th, Aust, Inf. Brigade 14th, instant 6th, Aust, Tuf, Brigade 15th instant ----17th, instant ---- 7th, Aust, Inf. Brigade 18th, instant ---- 2nd, Aust, Pionetr En.

The entraining officer will report to the R.T. C. one and half hours before the departure of the first train. He will remain until the last train is loaded and proceed in it to BAPAUME. The detraining officer will proceed to BAPAUME in the first train, report to the E. T. O. there immediately on arrival and remain at the station until the troops from the last train have left the yard.

- Each Unit will send an officer ahead to report to the Entraining Officer with a state showing the exact number of men to be entrained so that the train accommodation can be properly allotted.
- Strict discipline will be maintained at the entraining and detraining stations and en route: the necessary picquets will be detailed to maintain order and prevent troops straggling or leaving the train.
- The 5th. Australian Infantry Brigade will detail a guard 10. of one N.C.O. and 8 men to mount over the ammunition depot at PUCHEVILLERS Station at 7 a.m. on 14th. June: the guard will remain on until immediately prior to the departure of the last train/ when it will be taken off and entrain. from that station,

- (a) Latrines Proper latrine accommodation must be provided in every camp and kept in proper order. Old trenches and shell holes, are not to be used as latrines, and disciplinary action is to be taken against all S. ANTENS TERMS ACHIET LE C. SC S.D.) FOR DELECT DELECT
 - (b) Rubbish is not to be left about or thrown into shell holes or old trenches, but destroyed in incinerators which are to be established in every camp.
- (c) Camps are to be kept clean in particular each camp is to have a proper ablution place - indiscriminate washing soon soils the whole camp.
- (d) Horse lines are to be kept clean of manure which is to be removed daily and close packed. t dwomen blunds emiend

- Water, (a) Water for drinking and cooking is only to be drawn from water points or wells tested and found fit for use. It is to be drawn in either water carts or petrol tins and at once treated with the emount of bleaching powder laid down; one of the Medical details attached to the unit is to supervise the drawing of the water and attend to the CHLORINATION of it, and the Medical Officer will exercise a constant supervision. mercace bus miscret
- (b) Brigades will supervise the watering of horses at the water points in their areas and prepare and issue Time Tables to all units using the water point to avoid congestion at the troughs or on the roads near by.

Horses going to and returning from water are not to use main roads but side tracks.

5. Canteens.

6. Baths.

There are baths at SUCRER III BAPAUME H. 27. a. 8. 1. (No. 1) and N. 11. a. 7. 9. (No. 2).

No. 1 Baths are allotted for the ensuing week to 5th. Australian Infantry Brigade, 6th. Australian Infantry Brigade and 7th. Australian Infantry Brigade. and Divisional troops will use No. 2 baths arranging times direct with Divisional Baths Officer at D. H. Q.
