



Barrel is to be left behind in charge of our men remaining here. 13 CHESHIRE RIDGE a steady downpour of rain commenced rarly this morning, and lasted for two hours, chen cleaning up, and breaming near 4 cool. Voders come out that we are to move at seven to night. None of over men, except the machine gun erw, went into the trenehro, 14 SARPI CAMP, MUDROS. Last night wer moved off at seven orlock, and imbarked from angae at 11 pm, the whole brigade of 4 reglo were put on board one beloge, we were put on board the asmanish and arrived in medros at 10 a m, were landed at the RE whorf, and walked to camp here, a distance of 3 miles. all tamp arrangements in a frimetive state yet, but hourly improving 15 d. bamp MUDROS. To-day has mortly bun spirit in settling down our new camp all arrangements of which are fairly statesfactory; a shortage of tents bring the only real meonormaner. Livet Ranstrad ortunard to tamp to day, and was appointed adjutant. Several details 16 600 and men also returned to comp Thos. M'barroll It.

1915.

Sept. 16. SARPI CAMP MUDROS.

Very wet day. Orders that the Brigade will move camp to sight on hill west of the position.

Moved to new camping ground today. Ground dried up by strong wind & sun.
