

Hdqrs. 1st. Anzac.	15.		Visited Hdqrs. 2nd. Army-question of repair of guns. We get ours repaired in "B" Section. Major Gransden, A.O.D., Rue-de, la-Gare, Bailleul. Travelling workshops are practically under Army control. R.O. 994 - D.D.O.S. 38/76. Man allowed to retain his worn-out boots provided it does not lead to premature condemnation. Re Salvage Coys. and collection of stores. A.Q.M. G., 3317. D.D.O.S. Q/106 "any transport required is found from the Divl. Train". Many Divs. have Div. Armr. shops - not a bad idea.
