FERRY POST	2-6-16	1800.	Yesterday and today the Sections have been engaged in pontooning, trestle bridging, and demolitions, and this afternoon, tents were struck, and arrangements made for the move tomorrow to MOASCAR.	
MOASCAR	3-6-16	1800	The Coy marched out of FERRY POST with DIV. CAV., DIV CYCLISTS, PN. BN. and 15 th F. Co. ENGRS., crossing the CANAL, at 05.15, and arriving at MOASCAR CAMP. at 0730, the remainder of the day was spent preparing camp.	
MOASCAR.	10-6-16	1800	During the present week the Sections have completed a mess hut, cook's shelters, larder, and stables for the use of the Coy, the Sections have also been busy pontooning on the SWEET WATER CANAL, using our own bridging material. The G.O.C. inspected the divers, harness, and vehicles on the 5 th inst at 0800, and the Sappers, at pontooning on the 6 th inst, at 0830. On the 6 th inst 12 mules were sent away, being loaded up at MOASCAR STATION.	B

"	25-6-16	2000	Anchored in harbour at MARSA SCIROCCO, MALTA. at 0600	
"	26-6-16	2000	Left again at 1830 escorted by a T.B.D.	
ON TRAIN.	29-6-16	2200	Anchored yesterday at 20.00 in MARSEILLES HARBOUR and disembarked at 1400 today. The Coy. less CAPT CARR. 51. ORS vehicles, and horses, entrained with 59 TH BN. & 15 TH F. CO. ENGRS for HAZE BROUCK, leaving MARSEILLES at 2200.
