

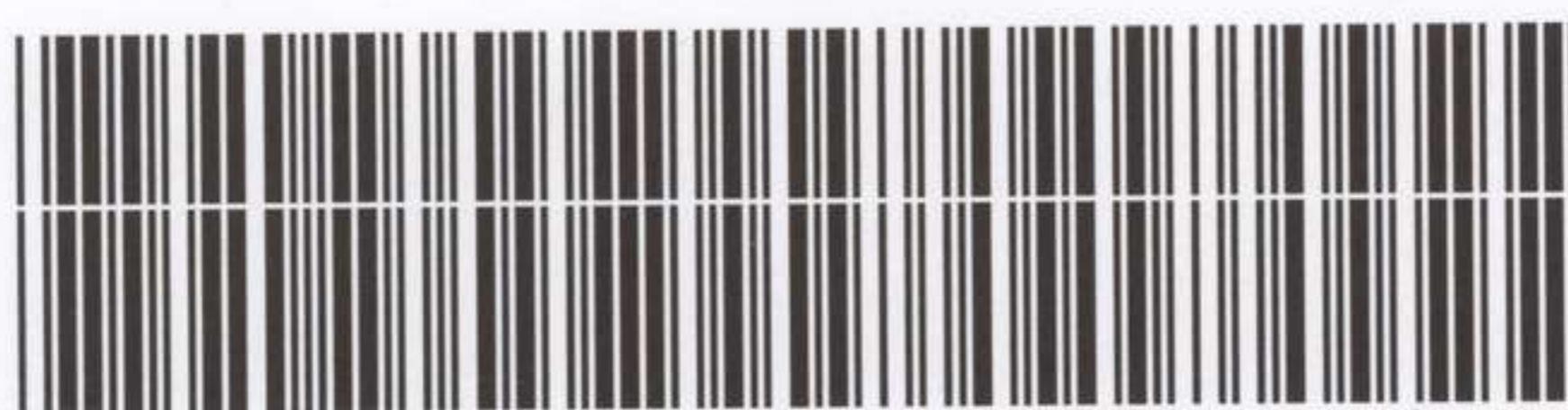

18th April 1919

WAR DIARY FOR APRIL 1919

1st to 3rd Preparations were made for the despatch of the second draft from from the Unit The time being occupied by medical inspections and Boards The second quota of 1 Officer (Lt WILSON "M M") and 68 Other ranks marched out to concentration camp at GAMACHES

4th to 18th The number of men left of the company strength was, after the 2nd draft had left the unit was ~~15~~ ¹⁶ including those on leave, attached C R E, and Corps Workshops

On the 8th the second draft left GAMACHES for LE HAVRE with Embarkation Quota No 29

On the 18th the three Field Companies were merged into a Divisional Engineers Details Company and their existence as separate units ceases
