1st August, 1917.

1. The 4th Australian Division (less artillery) will relieve the 3rd Australian Division (less artillery) in line, under arrangements to be made between Divisions.
2. Relief to be completed by daylight 5th August.
3. Command will pass on completion of relief.
4. The 3rd Australian Division will on relief move into Corps Reserve in the BERQUIN area. - Headquarters VIEUX BERQUIN.
5. The 3rd Australian Divisional Artillery will remain in line and will be attached to the 4th Australian Division.
6. The 3rd Australian Division will relieve the parties of the 4th Australian Division and New Zealand Division employed under the C.E., 2nd ANZAC.
7. ACKNOWLEDGE by wire.
