

Enemy has retired under pressure in a S.W. direction from the canel NEUF FOSSE and is holding the reverse slope of the ridge behind BLENDECQUES, WARDRECQUES, RACQUINGHEM.

Prepare a scheme for defence of Bridge across Canal, NEUF FOSSE, at WARDRECQUES and provide an alternative crossing for first line transport ( to three ton motor lorries ) in case bridge is destroyed by shell fire.

2 Coys infantry, 2 sections, M.G.Gunners available for defences; 1 Field Coy with attached infantry for works on defences. Details of work and distribution of parties to be given.

Schemes for defence to be completed and handed in by 9 pm 13th.

Schemes for alternative bridging by 5.50 pm 14th.
