

INTELLIGENCE BULLETIN.

AUGUST 9th, 1915.

(i)

GENERAL. The Kurds have occupied MUSH and KHARPUT and have proclaimed Abdul Riza Bedz-Khan as Governor General.

This action on the part of the Kurds should have a considerable effect upon the situation in Central Anatolia and be of great assistance to the Russian advance from the Caucasus.

SUBMARINE. A British submarine torpedoed a Turkish battleship of the "Torgut Reiss" class off Gallipoli yesterday morning. Another submarine sank a large gunboat in the Marmara and a large empty transport in the Straits.

The two submarines together bombarded troops proceeding west along road near Gallipoli all through the day of August 7th. Troops were much delayed and had many casualties.

PRISONERS. During last two days prisoners have been taken by the Army Corps from the following regiments:-

By Anzac - From regiments 13, 14, 25, 32, 47, 48, 72.

By 9th Corps - do. do. 32.

By 8th Corps - do. do. 30 and 46.

By French - do. do. 42.

(i) NOTE. The Persian Kurds are a powerful group of tribes, who, for the last 30 or 40 years, have been a constant source of disturbance in Central Asiatic Turkey and Armenia. They played, as between the Turks and Armenians the role of "tertius gaudens", and derived advantage from both sides in the persecutions and massacres of Armenia.

A prisoner of the 14th Regiment stated yesterday that his regiment had been in the Peninsula for some 3 months. When his company left ADRIANOPLIS it mustered 281 men and 5 officers. Of this original strength no officers now remain and only 16 men.

The interrogation of fully 100 prisoners during the course of the day has brought out one point very clearly. It is that in drafting men to fill gaps in the Peninsula forces the Turks have had to abandon all semblance of their territorial organisation. Men from Trebizonde, Smyrna, Konia and Adrianople are all jumbled together, showing the urgency of the demand for replacements.

It was also noticed that to certain questions, especially regarding supplies and ammunition the prisoners gave set and uniform answers.

REPORT ON THE CAPTURE OF AN ENEMY TRENCH NAMED
TURKISH DESPAIR.

The system of trenches called the TURKISH DESPAIR is situated N.E. of a work constructed gradually on HOLLY RIDGE by the 3rd Australian Brigade during June and July, and called TASMANIA POST. This Post is on the near ~~on~~^{or} West side of HOLLY RIDGE. It had no great field of fire across the ridge, and did not command the further valley, called the Valley of Despair. The Turks had occupied the Eastern crest of HOLLY RIDGE, with a good fire trench, and had made long communication trenches up to it from the valley. This trench stretched along the front of TASMANIA POST, and also round its North East flank, extending into a cornfield at the head of HOLLY SPUR.

The flank of TASMANIA POST was threatened by this extension, which occupied ground which it had been the intention to include in TASMANIA POST originally.

The task of taking the work was given to the 3rd Australian Brigade. Preparations were required for a continued occupation of the work after capture; the attack was therefore deferred until the 31st July. The preparations included the driving of four galleries under the enemy trenches.

The plan of attack was as follows:-

At 10.15 p.m. on the 31st July, selected howitzers and 18 pounders were to fire on the enemy works in the neighbourhood of TURKISH DESPAIR, and into the valleys near them. At the same time the four mines were to be fired and four columns of 50 men each were to assault and occupy specified lengths of the trench. These columns were to consist of 20 men bayonet party, 10 bomb throwers, and 20 working party from the 11th Battalion of the 3rd Australian Brigade with reserves in readiness; the covering fire was arranged by other units

of the 5rd Brigade on either flank. Strong fire demonstations were to be made in other parts all along the Anzac line, and a monitor was asked to shell Turkish trenches on the coast South of our right flank.

The bombardment began at 2215, and the mines were fired at 2226. One of these mines, the heaviest, failed, but the other three exploded, and the attacking columns went forward at once crossing our own barbed wire on planks, and were into the craters almost before the debris had all come down. The portion of trench which had not been blown in owing to the failure of the mine held a little while but was gallantly carried by a party of 25 men sent in from the reserve.

The assaulting parties then began to work right and left along the captured trenches, and succeeded in making good about 200 yards length, including a detached piece on the right. The sandbags on the parapets were shifted over and a fair firing trench was made. Work was also commenced on opening up the mine galleries as communication trenches a work which was possible at once owing to the open craters left by the explosion having freed fumes. A communicating sap between the main trench and the detached portion was also begun on but this was not completed till 3 p.m. next day. The Turkish communication trenches were blocked.

There was no real counter attack, but ineffective bomb attacks were made along the captured front and up the communication trenches. These gave a little trouble, but were all repulsed.

Our casualties in this affair amounted to 11 killed and 74 wounded, among the killed being Colonel Harris commanding the 5th Light Horse which was making a fire demonstration on the right flank.

The Turkish killed are estimated at at least 100. Sixty

bodies were seen lying around the work, and there must be many more in the scrub around and in the neighbouring trenches. A prisoner taken in the second affair of TASMANIA POST stated that the 48th regiment was defending the post and that when the explosion of the mines took place their captain grew frightened and fled before our attack. For this he was sentenced to death and the officer in charge of the supports was court martialled also. The company holding the post lost three fourths of their number in killed and wounded. The post was renamed Leane's Post, after Captain Leane, who led the attack upon it.

Prisoner also states that out of 250 men, 90 only answered to their names at roll call next day

Work continued on making the captured trenches into a ^{fire line} strong/with good communications to the rear.

Minor counter attacks, chiefly with bombs, were made on most nights, but no serious attack was made until the early morning of the 6th August, when at 0430 the enemy commenced a severe bombardment of the works with shrapnel and high explosive which partially demolished the parapets and caused severe casualties. Ten minutes later a heavy rifle and machine gun fire was opened from the Turkish works all round, and a party of 100 men who had crept into some dead ground below the post began to bomb the trench heavily. Of these a party of about 25 obtained a footing in the trench on the Southern end, and seized the right communication trench leading to TASMANIA POST.

Counter attacks were organized at once by the 11th Battalion. A party of 25 led by 2nd Lieut. Frockter (killed) dashed over the parapets towards that portion held by the enemy. About half reached the parades but were unable to dislodge the enemy. Another party of 25 men then went forward under a very heavy fire and retook the trench successfully, killing the Turks in it, and taking 6 prisoners in the right communication trench. The leader of this party

2nd Lieut. Franklin, was dangerously wounded.

Another counter attacking party, sent to clear the ground North of the post suffered severely, only 3 returning out of 25. The enemy's attacks were kept up till 10.30 a.m., when they gradually died away under a very effective bombardment opened on them with howitzers and field artillery.

The casualties in this action amounted to *

Killed - 3 officers, and 50 others. Wounded and missing - 3 officers and 100 others.

It was estimated at the time that the enemy had 50 killed, 40 being actually in view. The prisoner who is quoted above stated that after the loss of TASMANIA POST another captain came forward and volunteered to recapture the lost trenches or die; if they gave him two companies, saying the Turks could turn their machine guns on his force if it failed and retired.

This is what actually happened and the prisoners state that both companies were wiped out, for the most part by their own machine gun when they tried to retire.
