Havre	1918 Feb 28th		<p><u>MENS MESSING.</u> During the month No 1 Mess Hut has been painted and decorated.</p> <p><u>WEATHER.</u> With the exception of the last few days of the month the weather was fine, and the buds on the trees started to open, and some of the summer birds began to return,. A sudden drop in the temperature on the 26th culminated in a heavy fall of snow on the 28th.</p> <p><u>HEALTH OF TROOPS.</u> The health of the troops continues good. Two cases of Measles were reported during the month and the Contacts sent to Isolation Camp. No fresh cases of the disease is apparent.</p> <p><u>GARDENING.</u> During the month an area of $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the Depot and $\frac{1}{2}$ acre near Montivilliers was placed under cultivation. A horse was borrowed from the Remount Depot and a plow rented and the ground has been thoroughly worked and manured. 1500 Cabbage plants, 1200 lettuce plants have been planted. Plots of Turnips, Carrots, Parsnips, Broad Beans and Onions have been sown under glass and will be transplanted as season permits. $\frac{1}{2}$ acre has been prepared for potatoes which will be planted at the end of this month.</p>
