

During the month No 2 Mess Hut has been painted and decorated. March 31st Havre The weather has been fine throughout the month. HEALTH OF TROOPS. The health of the Troops continues good. One case of Mumps and one of Measles was reported and contacts sent to Isolation. No further cases were reported. GARDENING. Vegetable Seeds and plants have been planted out and all progressing favourably. KITCHEN BYE-PRODUCTS. A return of Sale of Kitchen Bye-Products for the first three months under the new organisation (Authority L of C No AH 9300/73T 12-12-17) Dec to Februare shown as under and for comparison a Statement of sale for the last 3 months (Septr to November inclusive) prior to new organisation, is also shown. It should be noted that more than the normal aver--age of roast beef was supplied to the troops, and that the high average of fat recovered is brought about through every viligance in the saving through meat time stock pots etc. Frozen Rabbits were substituted for meef on 4 days during the month of March. Full use of dripping was made in preparation of Steam puddings and roast etc. Large quantities of vegetables were purchased from Regimental Funds. The average cost of Potatoes is 16 Francs a cwt.
