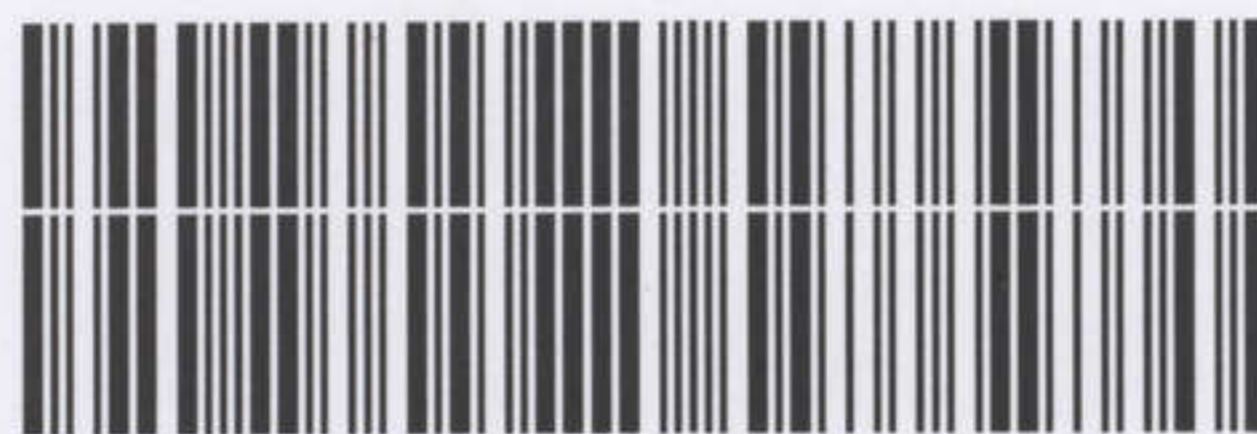

Repatriation and Demobilization.

1. Embarkation Quota No. 52 will be organised ready for entrainment at CHARLEROI to proceed to HAVRE enroute to Australia on May 12th.

Quota and one retained by each Senior Officer. The O.C. Quota will forward one copy to Repat. & Demob. A/4 Aust. Bde Group Headquarters.


