

During the hours that the troops are off parade the river is crowded with men bathing from CERISY down to CORBIE. As a result of the attractions offered by the River the hot baths installed at CERISY and BOUZINCOURT as well as those already in existence at CORBIE have not been utilised as largely as usual, though every man is bathed in them once a week, when he receives an issue of clean clothing.

Remarks and Date Hour Place Summary of Events and Information references to Appendices Between 2100 and 2200 tonight two hostile bombing planes were brought down by our fighting 14/9/18. BUIRE WOOD planes, just outside the Divisional Area. J.16.b.0.5 Appen-Divisional Boundaries slightly adjusted. Battle Instructions Series "D" Nos. 7 & 8 issued dix regarding the forthcoming attack on the outpost system of the HINDENBURG LINE (vide Appendix 8 & 9) dix (8 Appen dix 9. It rained heavily today, which made the work of dumping the necessary ammunition at the guns and of establishing the Infantry Reserves of ammunition much harder than normally; but the work has progressed satisfactorily. Battle Instructions Series "D" Nos. 9 and 10 were issued regarding the forthcoming operations 15/9/18. Appen (vide appendix 10 & 11) dix 10 Appen-i dix 11 Capt. A. LAUGHLIN "MC" .S.O. 111 left for AUSTRALIA on 1914 furlough today. R. WERTHEIM officiates temperarily. The Administrative arrangements for the forthcoming attack are progressing favourably, 16/9/18. and will be completed by about 1200 tomorrow. A severe thunderstorm and gale of wind during the night with heavy rain somewhat interfered 17/9/18. with the ammunition dumping arrangements, as well as the supply of water, but everything was completed by 1800 today. The attack today, which opened at 0520, was perfectly successful, in spite of the heavy 18/9/18. rain showers, which persisted all night and made the ground very slippery.

By night fall both attacking Brigades had gained all their objectives. The total number of unwounded prisoners reported up to 6 pm. is 60 Officers 1369 Other Ranks. Information was received this morning from Australian Corps that a party of Officers and Other Ranks, who embarked from AUSTRALIA in 1914, and who had not since returned to that country were to be sent to AUSTRALIA on six months furlouhh. 



1. (i) In continuation of Battle Instructions, Series "D" Nol. the attached map is issued for information.

(ii) The lanes of advance of the 5th. Aust. Div. on the right and 3rd. Aust. Div. on the left are shown, also the vafious bounds qiven as objectives to, these Divisiona.

(iii) The 4th. Aust. Div. is to follow up in support of the 5th. Div. The 1st. Aust. Div. in support of the 3rd. Aust. Div. Troops of the 111 Corps will be on the left of the 3rd. Aust. Div.

- It is probable that the Corps frontage will swin in a N.E. 2. direction from the line VERMAND-ROISEL, and the probable boundaries of the Corps will run as shown by dotted REEN LINES.

During the forthcoming battle Intelligence Instructions as laid down for operations on 9th. August and 23rd. August., will be adhered to.

The following alterations however, will come into effect.

2. (a) The D.A.P.M. will have a screen of M.M. Policemen stationed along the Divisional front, at an approximate distance of 1 mile from the front line. This screen will cover all routes from the front line in the Divisional Area.

in the line for prisoners who may be mis-directed.

(d) Close touch between the Divisional Cage, D.H.Q. and Headquarters of Brigades will be maintained and any information of value gained by the Divisional Intelligence Officer will be immediately forwarded to the those concerned.

(e) The D.A.P.M. will keep a close check of the number of prisoners
