

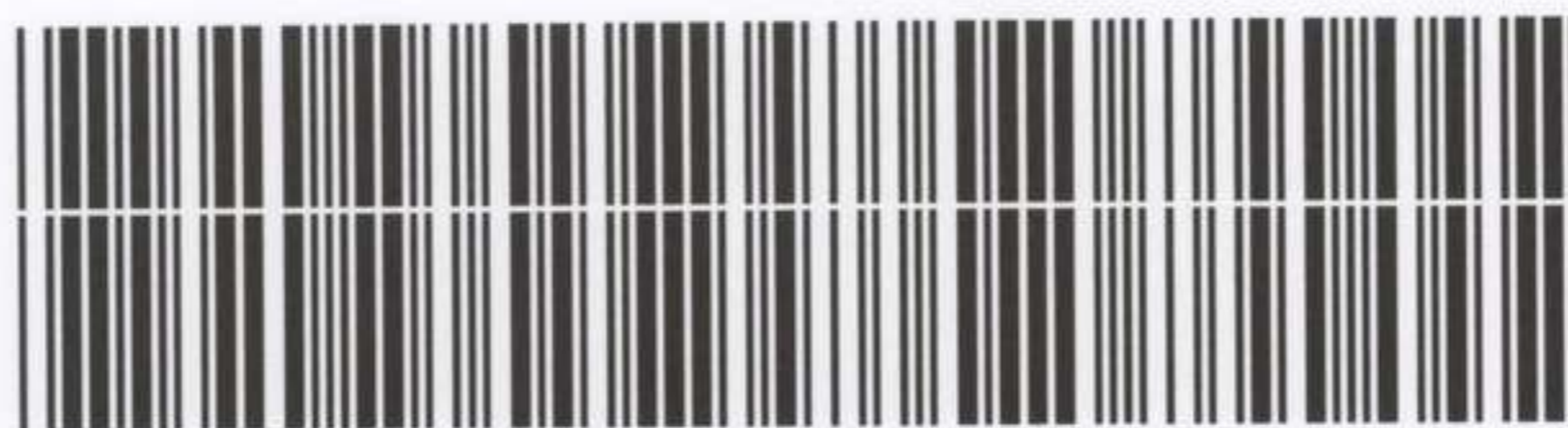

Disposal of personnel who have not rejoined a unit
before its cadre leaves FRANCE?

1. " All personnel who have not rejoined the unit or been transferred to another establishment before the cadre of the unit leaves FRANCE, owing to their being "Absent without leave", or men whose whereabouts cannot be traced, will be transferred to a special detachment administered by Australian Sect. 3rd Echelon. A nominal roll of all such personnel setting out number, rank, name and the fullest possible information as to their whereabouts, will be furnished by the unit direct to Australian Section 3rd Echelon, and the transfer will be effected from the date of the return.

ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS NO 74

1. The Quota mentioned in Admin. Instructions No. 72 will be called Quota No. 54.
2. The allotment already shown will stand except A.A.M.C. whose allotment is reduced to 6. Aust. Corps Hqrs. will provide emergencies, demands for which will be made as vacancies arise.
3. The Quota will be commanded by Lt-Colonel J. W. Mitchell, D.S.O., 8th Battalion who will select his Ship's Staff and forward a nominal roll of such to this office by May 14th.
4. a. The Quota will move to "B" Div. Rft. Camp on May 15th reporting prior to 12 noon. Rations up to midnight May 15/16 will be carried.
b. "B" Div. Rft. Camp will ration the Quota up to midnight May 17/18th and will place 2 days rations on the train.
5. O.C., No. 54 Quota will arrange billeting parties to report to "B" Div. Rft. Camp at 14.00 May 14th. The Officer i/c these parties will have a state showing the organisation of the Quota and the No. of Officers and other ranks in each Company. He will arrange that a proportion of cooks are sent to "B" Div. Rft. Camp on 14th May to prepare a hot meal for the Quota on arrival.
6. Five lorries will be at the disposal of O. C. Quota at 09.00 May 15th for the conveyance of stores, etc. to the Rft. Camp.
7. A rear party will be left to clean up after the departure of the troops and will rejoin the quota on the completion of such duty. Billets, Cookhouse, Offices and latrines will be left in a clean condition.
8. ~~As units bill forward to this office not later than May 12th~~ a nominal roll of officers accompanying Quota, a marching out state showing Officers, Substantive N.C.O's and men and a statement in accordance with Admin. Inst. No. 31, para. 2.
9. The amounts set out in Admin. Inst. No. 72 para. 2 should be paid at once to Paymaster, "B" Div. Group.
10. All outstanding claims must be investigated and settled before the unit leaves for "B" Div. Rft. Camp.
11. Personnel will be medically examined before the concentration at "B" Div. Rft. Camp and again after concentration.
X are issued by "B" Div. Rft. Camp.
Order regarding discipline. "good routine on the train journey to HAVRE" X Particular attention is directed to the danger of men travelling on the roofs, steps and buffers of trucks and steps will be taken to prevent men doing so.

5. The Quota will move to "B" Div. Rft. Camp on May 20th reporting before 12 noon. Personnel will report with rations to midnight May 20/21st.

a. "B" Div. Rft. Camp will ration the Quota up to midnight May 22/23rd and will place 2 days rations on the train.

6. O.C., No. 49 Quota will detail billeting parties to report at "B" Div. Rft. Camp at 14.00 May 19th. The Officer in charge billeting parties will have state showing the composition of the Quota and the number of Officers and other ranks in each company. A proportion of cooks will be sent to "B" Div. Rft. Wing on 19th to assist the kitchen staff in preparing a hot meal for the troops on arrival.

7. Rear parties will be left by all units to clear up after the departure of the troops and will rejoin Quota on the completion of such duty. Bilets, Offices and cookhouses will be left in a clean condition and latrines will be filled in. The Officer i/c Rear Party will report to the Local Burgomaster 3 hours after the departure of the troops to obtain a clearance. Four lorries will be at the disposal of the O.C. Quota at 09.00, May 20th for the transport of stores.

8. Units will furnish to this office by 18th May a nominal roll of Officers accompanying the quota, and marching out state showing number of Officers, substantive N.C.O's and men also a statement in accordance with Admin. Instruction No. 31 para.2.
