"	5.		"Q" branch required an urgent local purchase today for night raiding in snow of white material for overalls, but after making arrangements with D. H. Q. for a car, it failed to arrive, so was unable to comply. Bombs from hostile aircraft very close last night.	GA
"	6.		Car reported back from column. Bought 830 metres of white material in AMPIENS for purpose above mentioned.	GA
"	7.		Proceeded to A.D.O.S. re Artillery Re-organisation & reported stores returned to me on account of 22 nd Brigade being broken up.	GA

"	14		To AMIENS for local purchases	
"	20		Nothing of importance to record except that stores occasionally arrive two or three days after tabled times (Bulk issues) which means that demands are duplicated. No doubt this is due to scarcity of truckage.	G.H.
"	21		6 th A.F.A. Brigade moved to C.O. 1 st Arzac loops Troops - this is now the Army Brigade. A.D.O.S. visited ALBERT & called a conference of the Divisional Ordnance Officers re the Artillery Reorganization	G.H.
"	22		In consequence of the move of one Brigade of Artillery, I have re-adjusted my Troops a little. N.C.O. in charge of Divisional Troops now attends to all Divisional Artillery L.A.C. & a few small units, the Brigade W.C.s. have been given other units in place of the Artillery Brigade.
