

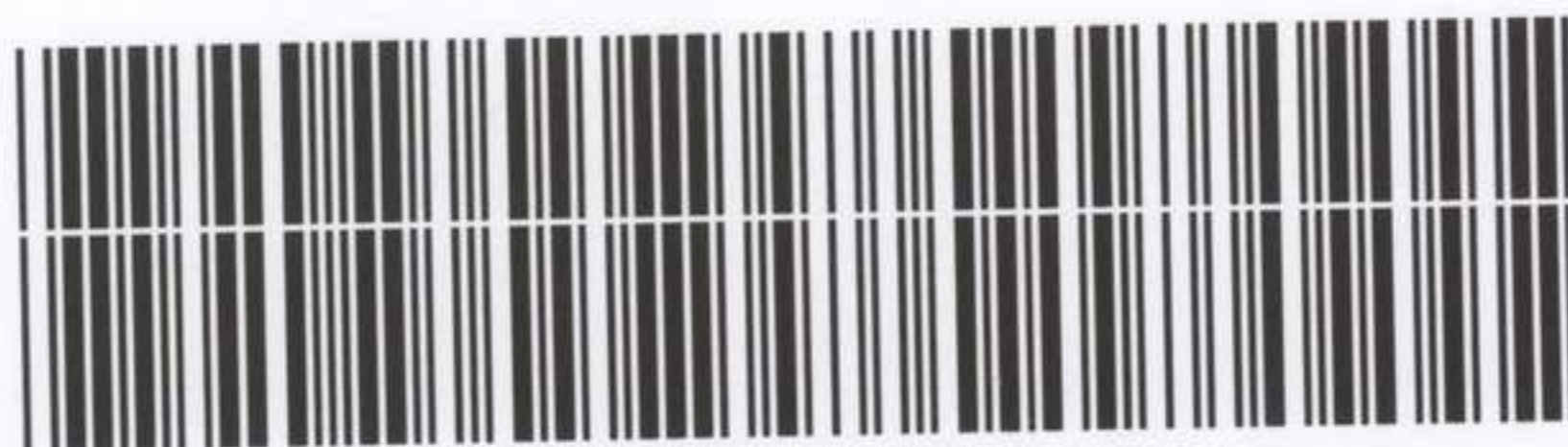

ENTRAIN-
MENT.

1. 4th Australian Division (less Artillery and Motor Vehicles) will entrain, commencing 8th instant, as shown in table attached.

Movements to entraining stations will be made under orders of G.O.C. Infantry Brigades, and will be regulated as follows :-

- (a) Infantry and Pioneer Battalions. The transport to arrive at entraining Station 3 hours and remainder of Unit 1 1/2 hours prior to departure of train.
- (b) Other Units. To arrive complete 3 hours prior to departure of train.

No. troops to enter Station Yards until R.T.O. is ready for entraining.

Entrainment of Units must be completed half an hour before scheduled time of departure.

Breast ropes for horse trucks to be provided by Units. Lashing ropes for vehicles will be provided by R.T.O.

2. The D.A.A.G. will act as Entraining Staff Officer. The D.A.C.M.G. will act as Detraining Staff Officer. An Entraining Officer will be detailed by each Brigade to report to R.T.O. at their respective entraining stations. Tour of duty will continue until entrainment complete. A Detraining Officer will be detailed by each Brigade to proceed by first train.

- (b) Each Infantry Brigade will detail a party of 2 officers and 100 other ranks for unloading at detraining Station, to proceed by first train from each Group.

- AMMUNITION. 6. Units will travel with Mobile Echelons of ammunition full. Any ammunition held surplus to Echelons will be delivered to VII Corps Ammunition Dump MURLU Sheet 62 D.10.a. and receipt obtained.

- BAGGAGE
WAGONS. 7. Baggage and Supply Wagons of Train will accompany Units rejoining Divisional Train as soon as possible after detraining.

- POLICE. 8. The A.P.M. will detail for duty 1 N.C.O. and 6 Police to be at the Entraining Station and a similar number to be at the Detraining Station during the move. Those for Detraining Station will proceed by first train from Entraining Station. Parties at Entraining Station to proceed by last train.

- QUARTERING

MENTS. 9. The Staff Captains of 12th and 13th Aus. Infantry Brigades will proceed to the new area by road, under Divisional arrangements, on the 6th instant.

The Staff Captain 4th Aus. Infantry Brigade will proceed by No.1 Train on 8th instant, reporting to D.H.Q. BERTHEM on arrival.

Advanced Billeting Parties will proceed as follows :-


