

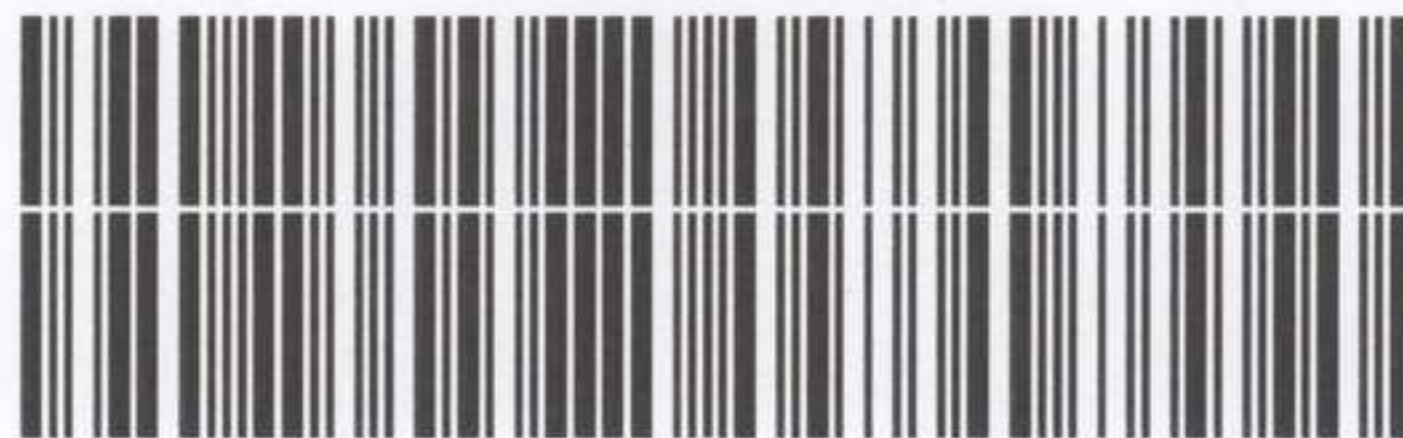

	May 12	0900	Ref:- Hospital Beds.- It has been found necessary to establish Annexes of the A.A.M.C. Tng. Cadre Hospital at the Isolation Camp, Woascar, where 5 beds have been established. This has proved of great service to the Camp, as by its means it has not been found necessary to evacuate so many men to Hospital. As a proof of the necessity of this Hospital, figures show that, for the last month, 80 cases were admitted to this Camp Hospital, and only 18 had subsequently to be evacuated to 2nd. A.S.Hospital. Secondly, owing to the inconvenience experienced in evacuating sick prisoners from the F.P.C., all of whom require escorts and guards while in Hospital, I have established 3 beds in a small Hospital within the F.P.C. Since this has been done there have been no evacuations to 2nd. A.S.H. to date.	SW
