

Divisional Gas Officer's Monthly Report.

Duties of Divisional Gas Officer as laid down in Australian Corps G90/177.

Advisory Under the General Staff his duties will be - To advise the Divisional General Staff on all matters connected with Gas or Flame and on Anti-Gas measures for the protection of the Divisional Area. To supervise the taking over of Anti Gas Trench Stores Operation.

2. On relief - outgoing and incoming, Divisional Gas Officers will render a certificate to the Corps Chemical Adviser that Anti-Gas Trench Stores and maps have been handed over to- and received by - the incoming Divisional Gas Officer.

3. To arrange with the Divisional General Staff to be at once notified of any Gas attack or Gas shell bombardment. To investigate and render reports and samples to the Corps Chemical Adviser.

- 4. To examine captured appliances dealing with Gas, smoke, flame etc. and report on same.
- 5. To supervise the production of smoke when required
- 6. To be present with the O.C. Special Coy. R.E. (Gas Brigade) when cylinder or projector Gas attacks are being made on the enemy.

Routine, To visit the Divisional Front and Divisional Artillery when the Division is in the line.

To visit all Units and inspect all Anti-Gas appliances.

To arrange for the inspection of Divisional Anti-Gas equipment

(reserve) as required.

To ascertain that all Units keep all Anti-gas equipment up to scale.

To arrange for the examination of salved Anti-Gas equipment.

To lecture to Units on Gas, Smoke, and Flame.

To arrange for the Anti-Gas instruction of all new Drafts.

Administration.

Small paper maps have been forwarded weekly to "G" Staff, showing i

colors the Area subjected to Gas bombardments during the week.

Some trouble has been experienced in making Units forward Indents fo Small Box Respirators and containers through Divisional Gas Officer, with liof faults attached. This procedure enables unnecessary condemning of sma Small Box Respirators to be checked. Training.

Two Brigades were continually in the line during the month and the reserve Brigade worked on defensive positions, consequently it was impossible

to carry out any training. At the Divisional Reinforcement Wing arrangements were made for instruction and testing of Anti-Gas equipment of reinforcements and men returned from hospital.

Shelling. Not so heavy as during the previous month and the casualties were

very few. Yellow Cross, Green Cross and Blue Cross were identified.

CORBIE again suffered, being heavily shelled on the 13th, 15th and 27th The village itself was evacuated; and picquets were put on the main road to stop traffic passing through.

There were also heavy bombardments of the Battery positions in Sheet 62d 0.15,16,21, and22 between FOUILLOY and VILLIERS- BRETONNEUX on the 13th

and 15th. A considerable number of casualties were caused on the 8th Bde. H. Q. after the shelling of CORBIE on the 13th and 15th, as result of remaining in a dug-out system, the area around which was drenched with Yellow Cross Gas

The Brigade Commander was advised by D.G.O. to move at once on the morning of the 15th, and a report to the same effect was sent to Divisional Headquarters, but the move was delayed until the 18th and casualties resulted.

The number of protective dug-outs and cellars in the area was largly increased and these have been found of great service during Gas Shell bombardments. The 5th Divisional Eng. did excellent work on these

Toward the latter end of the month Strombos Horns were installed on the Sector on the scale of 30 to a mile of front. These are only to be used in the event of cloud Gas attack.

Rattles and gongs are used for the alarms to warn men of Gas shell

attacks.

Sentries are always kept posted in order that men asleep may be awake-ned as quickly as possible.

Chloride of Lime has proved effective in neutralising Yellow Gross Gas in shell holes, but the amount required for same is very large.

Lt. Nash 14th Bde. Gas Officer reported on two occasions that poultices made of cold tea leaves were very effective in curing eyes affected with Yellow Cross Gas.

Masks of Artillery and Machine Gunners were fitted with new Triplex Eye Pieces, which have proved very efficient; enabling the Gunners to carry on duties during Gas shell bombardment with very little inconvenience.

Changes in Personnel.

It Shields 15th Bde. Gas Officer was evacuated, suffering from Trench Fever and Lt. Hodgson took over his duties.

Lt. Oldstrum 8th Bde. Gas Officer was wounded and gassed

and his duties were carried on by Lt. Mc Gill.

A Green Cross Gas Shell burst in the billet occupied by Sergeant Neil 14th Bde. Gas N/C.O. destroying his S.B.R.. His coolness and presence of mind in the matter of holding his breath enabled him to get away without being affected.

Duties of Brigade Gas Officers and N.C?O's

To carry out the weekly inspection of Anti-Gas Equipment of the Personnel attached to Brigade Headquarters and to prepare a list of shortages. To keep a record showing number and position of all Anti-Gas Trench Stores in the Bde. Area and prepare weekly reports to be forwarded to the Divisional Gas Officer on the following:-

1. Anti-Gas Equipment and inspections, consolidated weekly reports from Battn Gas N.C.O's.

2. Strombos Horns.

3. Other Anti-Gas Trench Stores.

a) Vermorel Sprayers

(b) Chemicals (c) Ayrton Fans (d) Vacuum Bulbs

(e) Gas proof Dug-outs

- (f) Number of Wind Vanes, Gongs, Alarms and Notice Boards showing Gas Zones in the Bde. Area.
- 4. Change in Personnel of Battn and Company Gas N.C.O's

To test and inspect all Anti-Gas appliances before they are distributed in the Bde. Area.

To visit all Strombos Horns in Bde. Area at least once a week.

To keep a nominal roll of Battn. and Coy. Gas N.C.O's. To I place useless or damaged containers of S.B.R's.

To have charge of chemicals for the Vermorel Sprayer solution To keep a supply of "S?K." liquid for testing the fit of masks.

To assist in training reinforcements.

To collect samples of Enemy Gas.

To collect any enemy Anti-Gas material

Administration.

During the period spent in reserve, Units were instructed in the proper method of forwarding indents for S.B.R.s., and in spite of the very strict testing of the respirators, a diminution in issue of S.B.R's and containers has resulted.

The copy of the daily Gas shelling wire to Corps and Army is now being forwarded to "G" Staff.

Returns from Units have been rendered correctly and up to time.

Training.

The Division went into Reserve Area on the 2nd inst. and the first

three days were given to rest.

Whilst out fot the 14 days the Bde. Gas Officers inspected Anti-Gas Equipment and all ranks had the fit of their masks tested in a Gas chamber.

One hour a week was given to Gas Training by all Infantry Units and by the time the Division went back to the Line every one was in possession of a serviceable respirator.

Demonstrations were not carried out as supplies could not be

obtained from Corps in time

Gas Shelling.

Since taking over the new Sector Gas Shelling of the Divisional Area has been light, only a few cases from Gas being reported Yellow Cross was principally used.

Protective Measures.

In reserve

Whilst two Companies of Machine Gunners had their masks fitted with

Triplex Eyepieces; the remainder of the Battn.being finished by the 23rd

The Medical Officers and stertcher bearers of the 8th Bde. were also fitted.

The new Area was very poorly provided with protected Dug-outs and cellars; these have been attended to and many others are now in the course of construction.

Sixty Strombos Horns have been distributed over the Divisional Area

Changes in Personnel.

It Shields loth Bde Gas Officer returned to duty in the early part of the month, but was severly wounded by H.E. and again

Lt. Dalglaith is now with the Brigade.

Sergeant Staley and Sergeant Harrold of the 8th Bde. and Corps
Gas School respectively exchanged places.
