

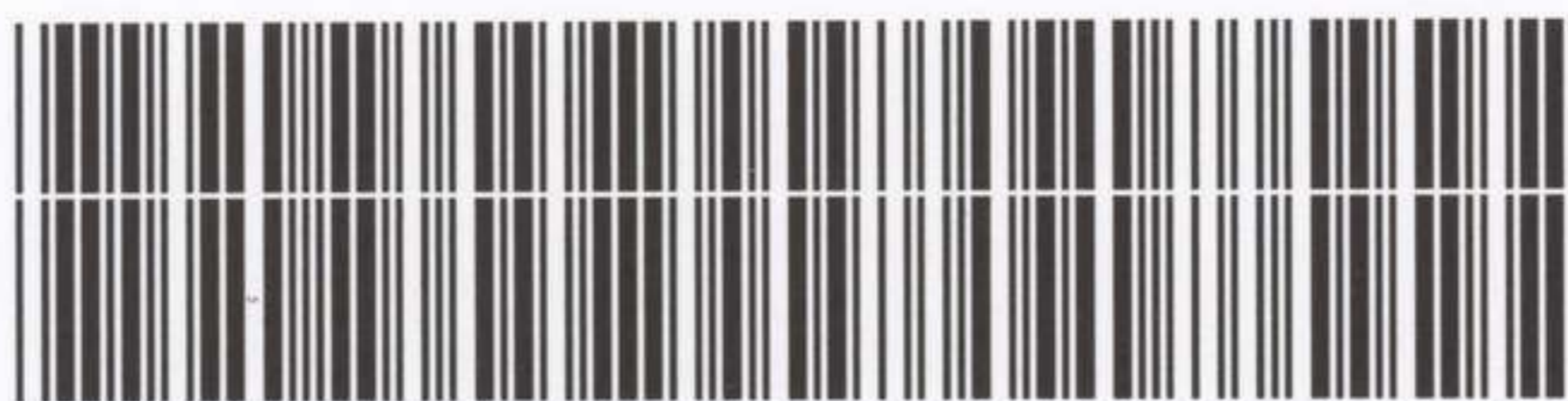

			<p>April 1. Packing of stores and equipment were continued and everything got ready to hand into D.A.D.O.S. This was a very busy time for all. All Transport Waggon etc, were returned to Vehicle Reception Park Charleroi, and final disposal of surplus stores and equipment took place on April 3. 1919 .</p>	
			<p>April 3. On the afternoon of 3/4/19 the troops commenced to move from Marcinel Haies to the new area Marcinelle, about 3 kel. from old area, the move was completed before night fall.</p>	
			<p>From April 4th till 12th April there was very little work done, Leave being granted freely which was availed of by large number troops. On April 12 No 28 Quota left , for return to Australia the Quota was comprised of 1 Officer Lieut. Elsum 6th Field Company A.E. and 30 other ranks from the 2nd Div. Engineers.</p>
