

1. During the past twenty-four (24) hours four prisoners have been taken from three different German Divisions and all agree that an attack is imminent on the front of the XV Corps, the objective being MONT DES CATS.

The plan appears to be to employ heavy gas sholling on the FOREST d'NIEPPE and to attack north of the forest. It is probable that gas may be expected on the STRAZERLE and FONTAINE HOUCK positions, and that the attack will be delivered between these three bastions.

Although the date of the attack is specified as the 2. 25th instant, the Army Commander wishes all preparations made each day as if the attack was coming the following morning.

The Divisional Commander desires that patrol activity 3. should be maintained, and that prisoners taken during the night should be interpogated on the spot, if this is possible, with a view to finding out whother the attack is coming the following morning.

The arrangements for turning out and assembling reserve troops should be perfected.

Gas shelling, particularly between 3 a.m. and 6 a.m., should be promptly reported to Divisional Headquarters.

Consequent upon the re-distribution of the Division and the organization of the Divisional sector on a one brigade frontage, and the withdrawal of the 17th Northumberland Fusilier Railway Pionoor Battalion, the following amondments will be made in the instructions contained in Doronco Organization papers, Series "B"

(a) Series "B", No. 8 will coase to be operative with the excep-

tion of paragraphs 5 and 6;

(b) Sorios "B", No. 8 will coase to be operative;
(c) Sorios "B", No. 12 is cancelled;
(d) Sorios "B", No. 14, paragraphs 1, 2, and 3 are cancelled.

The line brigade has organized the sector in three battalions 2. sections of defence, each battalien having two companies in the forward system, one company dotailed as garrison to the support system, and one company in reserve. One battalion is hold in brigade

reserve less one company allotted as garrison of STRAZETLE. The 1st Australian Pioneer Battalien will provide the garrison for the reserve system of the forward zone including the garrisons of defended localitios of ROUGE CROIX and PRADELLES. It will also

provide a nuclous garrison for the COURTE CROIX switche The battalion will be distributed on the following principles :-Companies will be distributed as garrisons to the sections in

which they are employed; No battalion reserve will be retained;

The total strength allotted to the garrisons of the defended localities of PRADELLES, ROUGE CROIX and the nuclous garrison of the COURTE CROIX switch will not exceed one and a half

companios: The remainder of the reserve line will be occupied by posts. (d) A post will not normally be of less strength than two sections of riflomon or one section of riflomen and one Lewis Gun section (approximate strength, 20 to 25 men).

A skotch of the distribution of the battalion showing the strongth and location of each post will be forwarded to 1st Aust.

Divisional Headquarters as soon as completed.

Reconnaissances should be unde in order to ensure that posts oun be rapidly manned. The instructions now in force as to manning the posts on the initiative of the O.O., 1st Australian Piencer Battalion, or in the case of detached companies on the initiative of Jompany Commandors, in the event of emergency, will continue in forco. After the first nuclous manning 0.0. 1st Ploncer Battalion will report the time estimated to man the defences from the present location of the companies after the receipt of the order "occupy defences" at Battalien Headquarters.

The nuclous battalien of the line brigade will remain respon-40 sible for the defence of the locality of BORRE.

SUPPORT BRIGADE. 5. (1) The support brigade will be prepared to counter attack in the event of an enemy penetration of the Divisional front, Routes will be reconneitred and assembly positions chosen -

(a) For a counter attack as laid down in D.H.Q. S/8339 deted

4th May, paragraphs 7 and 8; For a counter attack in the event of an enemy penetration (b) in the vicinity of STRAZEELE station.
