

RAFA 1/125,000 BEERSHEBA 1/125,000 20th September 1917

- In case of attack the Anzac Mtd Division will assemble at once at EL MELEK, where it will remain ready to operate against the enemy's left flank as soon as opportunity occurs.
- 2. The forming up place of the Brigade will be on the ground pointed out to Adjutants, south of C.M.R. lines.

The Brigade will form up in line of Regimental masses,

from left to right as follows:-

Brigade Headquarters
Signal Troop
Canterbury M.R. Regt.
Wellington M.R. Regt.
Auckland M.R. Regt.
Machine Gun Squadron
Mounted Field Ambulance.

The Canterbury M.R. Regt's left will rest on the road crossing the railway 300 yards NORTH WEST of No 3 REDOUBT.

- 3. From this point the Brigade will advance from the left and march to a point to be pointed out to Adjutants at EL MELAK.
- 4. Immediately orders are received to turn out the action of the Brigade will be as follows:,

Saddle up, Turn out, Water and march to forming up place.
Directly Regiments are turned out a representative of each Unit

will report to Brigade Headquarters.

In Watering care must be taken that regiments do not cross the Regiments of the 1st and 2nd Light Horse Brigades, when going or returning from, water.

Note. Should the Brigade have to turn out between the hours of 19 and 0530 horses will not be watered.

- 5. It is essential that representatives of each Squadron should visit the forming up place and reconnoitre the route they will march to it, so that they can find their way to it without loss of time by day or night.
- 6. In addition to the unexpended portion of the days rations, and on iron ration, all ranks will carry twenty four hours fodder on the horse.

Care should be taken to see that all water bottles are full.

- 7. The Brigade Transport will collect the two days emergency rations one days emergency forage, water, firewood, and any other articles for G.S. waggons from Unit Lines and have all G.S. waggons drawn up on the Brigade Transport lines ready to move on receipt of Orders.
- 8. Units will take their pumps and troughs with them on the limbers.
- 9. The Dury Regiment will detail an Officer to remain as O/C Camp Detail Each Unit will detail guards to look after their Camp.
