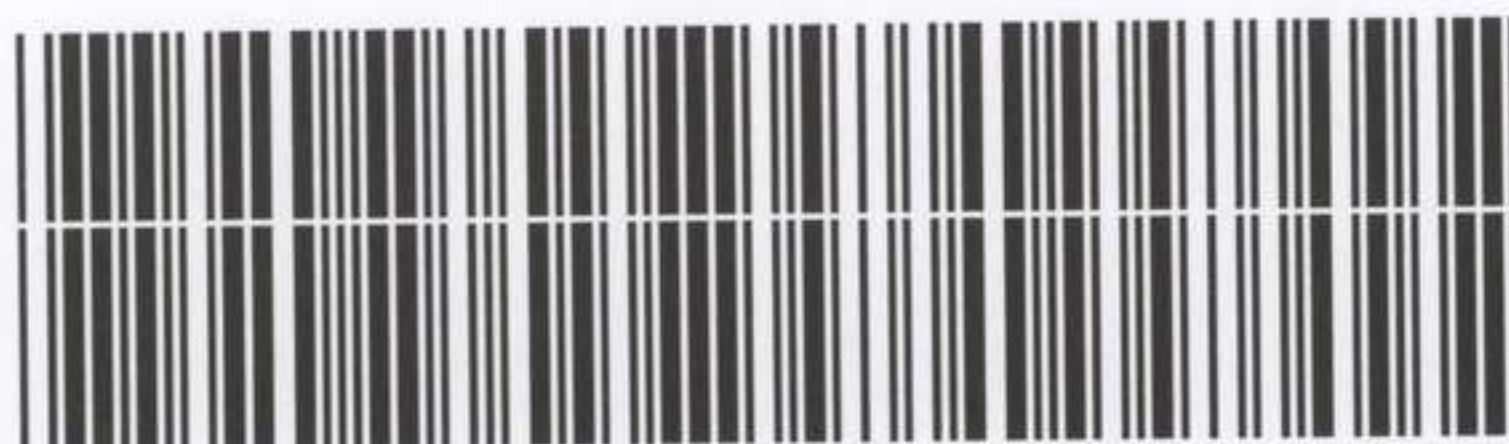

Military District (Victoria) which were retained for the re-organisation of the 3rd. Australian Camel Regiment (4th. L.H.).</p> <p>*****</p>	
	" 10		<p>The 4th. Australian Camel Regiment entrained at FERDAN and proceeded to ABBASSIA, Cairo, and reported to Headquarters, Imperial Camel Corps. This regiment was issued with Camels and equipped for service as camelry.</p> <p>*****</p> <p>The Military Mounted Police in Egypt were organised in terms of A.I.F. Order No. 264. All N.C.Os. and men borne on the establishment of Military Mounted Police of Brigades and attached to Divisional Headquarters and Training Depots and Camps, ^{were} will be transferred to the ANZAC Provost Police Corps, with their present rank whilst so employed.</p>
