INSTRUCTIONS AS TO THE USE OF THE SQUARES.

1. The large rectangles on the map, marked A, B, C, etc., are divided into squares of 100 yards each, which are numbered 1, 2, 3, etc. Each of these squares is subdivided into four smaller squares of 50 yards each. These smaller squares are numbered a, b, c, d. (See Square No. 2 in each rectangle).

A point may thus be described as lying within Square B, 4, a, b, etc.

2. To locate a point within a small square, measure the distance from the bottom-left corner of the square, and from the point by taking a series of steps from W. to E. along the bottom side, and from S. to N. along the right side, and the distance along the bottom side being always given by the first figure. Thus the point 'C' would be 37, 4, a, distance East and 4 distance North from origin.

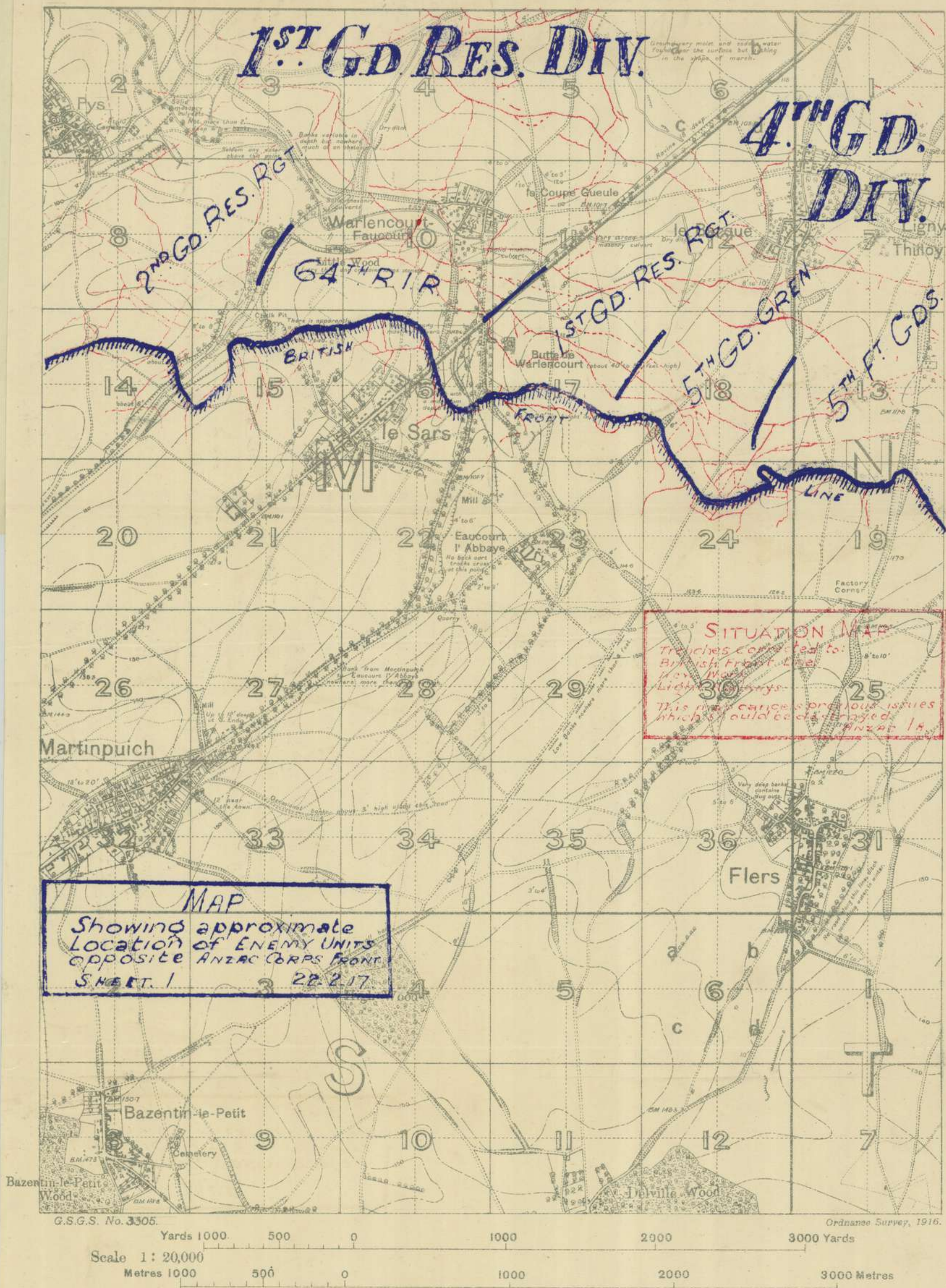

TRENCH MAP. FOURTH ARMY FRONT. MAP L.



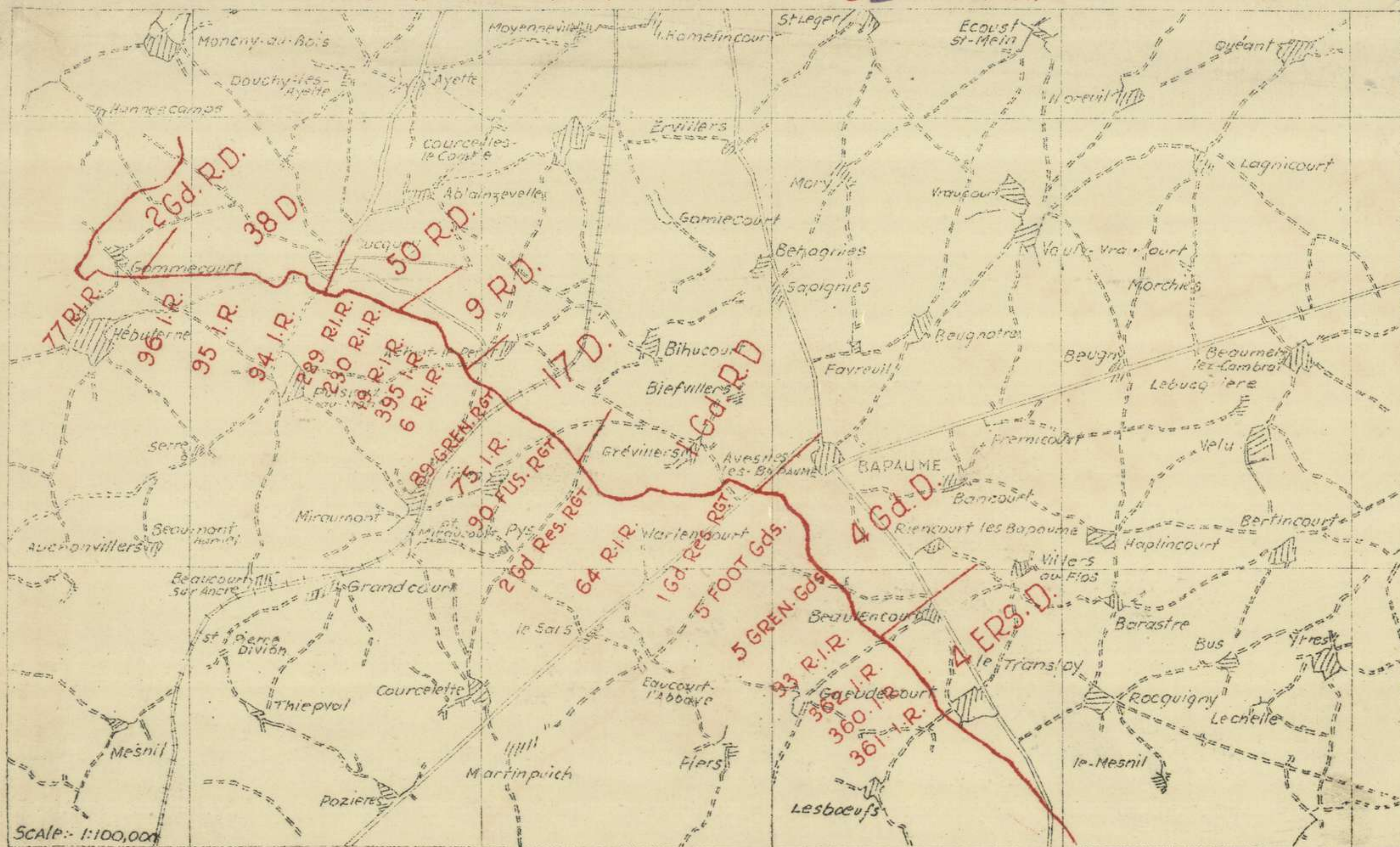
