



**INFORMATION.** 1. Recent reports tend to show that enemy patrols visit BIR SALMANA and HOD SALMANA, usually about dawn. They also seem to come into places visited by our troops as soon as they have left.

**EXECUTION.** 2. It is intended to make a reconnaissance of BIR SALMANA and HOD SALMANA with the following objects : -  
(i) To surprise such of the enemy as may be at these places at dawn.  
(ii) To capture any hostile patrol approaching these places at dawn.  
(iii) To destroy all enemy stores in the vicinity.  
Any serious engagement with the enemy is to be avoided.

**DATE.** 3. The reconnaissance will take place on Saturday, July 8th, Sunday, July 9th, and Monday, July 10th.

**TROOPS.** 4. The Force will comprise 2nd L.H. Brigade, and attached Regt. (less 5th & 12th Regts.) and 1 Regt., 1st L.H. Brigade. They will be divided as follows : -  
(a) For the reconnaissance -  
2nd L.H. Brigade and attached Regt. (less 5th & 12th Regts)  
(b) Covering Troops -  
1 Regiment, 1st L.H. Brigade.

**COMMAND.** 5. Colonel J. R. ROYSTON, C.M.G., D.S.O., Commanding 2nd L.H. Brigade, will command the Force.

**MOVES.** 6. (a) The Force will leave ROMANI at such an hour on Saturday, July 8th, to avoid moving in the heat of the day.  
Two Regiments will go to QATIA.  
Two Regiments will go to OCHRACIMA.  
They will bivouac here for the day.

(b) The Force will leave the bivouacs on the night July 8/9th at such an hour that they can begin the reconnaissance at dawn. On completion of the reconnaissance, the Force will withdraw, not delaying longer in the area BIR SALMANA, HOD SALMANA, BIR EL ABD, than is absolutely necessary.

The B.G.C. Force will decide whether he will return to ET MAIER on the night July 9th/10th, or halt for that night on the road, and, get back to ET MAIER on the morning of July 10th.

(c) The B.G.C., 1st L.H. Brigade, will detail 1 Regt., which will report to B.G.C. Force, as covering troops.

The B.G.C., Force will make use of these troops : -

- (i) To watch the country N. & S. of the VAPLA-BIR EL ABD Road during the reconnaissance.  
(ii) To provide escorts for the camel convoy accompanying the Force.  
(iii) To provide escort for the dressing station.  
(iv) The 5th L.H. Regt. will detail 1 Sqdn. to be at BIR EL SAMSAH at dawn on Sunday July 9th, and watch the country S & E of QATIA.

**AMMUNITION.** 7. 140 rounds G.M.L. per man, and 3,500 rounds per machine gun will be carried.  
100 camels for ammunition will be held in readiness at ROMANI STATION.

**WATER & FORAGE.** 8. One full days ration and one iron ration will be carried on each man. Two feeds will be carried in nosebags on each horse. Camels carrying 1 1/3rd full days rations for the men and 1 2/3rds rations for the horse for the Regiments who bivouac at OGHAMINA, and, 1/3rd rations for the men and two feeds for the horse, for the two Regiments bivouacking at QATIA will accompany the Force to OGHAMINA. Camels conveying one full days rations for the men and three feeds for the horse will accompany the two Regiments bivouacking at QATIA.

One full days rations and forage for two weeks will be held at ROMANI STATION from 1400, July 9th.

Camels no longer required at OGHAMINA or QATIA will return under escort to ROMANI STATION, leaving those places at such an hour on the afternoon of 8th July, as to avoid moving in the heat of the day.

The remainder will remain at OGHAMINA until they receive orders from D.C.C., 2nd I.M.Brigade.

**TRANSPORT.** 9. No transport other than camels for rations, water and forage, and the use of carts and sledges with the medical personnel will be taken.

**AMBULANCE.** 10. The 2nd I.M.Bld. Ambulance will move forward with the Bde on night July 8/9th, and establish a dressing station at HAMISAH. The D.C.C., and I.M.Bde will furnish a small escort to the dressing station.

Further instructions are being issued in detail by A.D.M.S.

**COMMUNICATIONS.** 11. The Signal Squadron will have communication established between Div. Headqtrs, the Force carrying out the reconnaissance, and the covering troops II and III of the QATIA - DIR LL BD road, and the Squadron 5th I.M.Brig. at MELLEH H. HAMISAH

**REPORTS.** 12. Reports and messages intended for D.C.C. will be sent to ROMANI after 1600 on July 8th.

Communication

The Reconnaissance Force will be connected with Divisional Headquarters by telegraph and visual communication

Telegraph.

"B" Troop under Lieut. Donkin will make good the line from ROMANI to BIR EL ABD, where the report centre will be established. A Signal Office will also be established at OGHRETINA. The report centre will fall back when the Reconnaissance Force passes through.

The 5th.L.H.Regiment will see that the cable-line running from BIR EL HAMISAH to the QATIA -DUEIDAR line is in working order, and will connect up on this line.

Linemen.

Two linemen with a D3 for each pair will be posted at ROMANI, QATIA, OGHRETINA, HOD ED DEBABIS and BIR EL ABD, and two for D.H.Q., who must be trained telephonists.

"B" Troop will find the above detail.

GeneralOperators.

Three operators will be taken by Lieut. Donkin for use at BIR EL ABD, two others being detailed to staff the Signal Office at OGHRETINA. Each party will carry two D3.

Visual.

Visual stations will be established by "D" Troop at KATIB GANIT and at OGHRETINA and by the 5th. Light Horse Regiment at Hill 583. The station at Katib Ganit and at OGHRETINA will consist each of

1 N.C.O.  
3 Rank and file.

Covering Troops

The Signal Officer 1st. Light Horse Brigade will arrange for communication between the covering Regiment and Report Centre.

ACP Office

Lieut. Stinson will remain in charge of ACP Office.

Transport.

The parties proceeding to OGHRETINA should be mounted on camels, which the D.C. "B" Troop will arrange to supply.

Rations.

One full day's ration and one "iron" ration will be carried on each man. Two feeds per horse to be carried. Camels proceeding to OGHRETINA should carry three full days feed on saddles.

Reports.

Reports and messages intended for D.H.Q. will be sent to ROMANI after 1600 on July 8th.





The Section Commander desires that the area round UMM AISHA (Square E.4 on 1/100,000 Map - QATIA) should be cleared of any natives and animals that may be located there.

Peaceful Bedouins with flocks should as far as possible be brought in by easy stages, and the numbers collected reported as early as possible so that arrangements can be made for their disposal.

Your Brigade (less 1 Regt) will carry out this work on Wednesday July 12th, Thursday July 13th and Friday July 14th (if necessary).

The following moves will take place : -  
On Wednesday July 12th.

Brigade Hdqtrs and 1 Regt and 1st L.H.F.S. will leave Camp on the afternoon of July 12th at such an hour as to avoid moving in the heat of the day and march to OGHRETINA where they will bivouac for the night, July 12/13th. 1 Regiment will leave Camp on the afternoon of July 12th at such an hour as to avoid moving in the heat of the day and march to HOD ES SAGIA where they will bivouac for the night July 12/13th.

Thursday July 13th.

1 Regiment (less escort for units remaining at OGHRETINA) will leave OGHRETINA at such an hour as to arrive at HOD ED DABABIS at dawn, leaving one squadron there to watch the country to the E. They will then form a driving line with the right on the QATIA - ABD road and the left on HAMMAM and drive towards OGHRETINA. The squadron watching the country should fall back with the driving line to OGHRETINA. The Regiment at HOD ES SAGIA will leave there so as to arrive at HOD EL MUHAMMAM at dawn and will drive in to OGHRETINA with the right on bub excluding HAMMAM and the left on HOD EL FAREIWA. The division of the square is shown on attached plan, and it is essential that the whole of the square should be well searched.

Supplies.

One days rations and water will be carried on the man and two feeds on the horse.

Camels conveying 1 days water and 1 feed per horse will accompany the Regiment to HOD ES SAGIA and will move under escort to OGHRETINA on the morning of 13th.

Camels conveying 2/3rds rations and 1 days water and 2 feeds for the Regiment moving to HOD ES SAGIA and 2/3rds rations and 1 days water and 3 feeds per horse for 1st Bde Hdqtrs, 1 Regiment and 1st L.H.F.A. will accompany the Brigade to OGHRETINA.

Ammunition.

140 rounds S.A.A. and 3,500 rounds per Machine Gun will be carried.

Dressing Station.

A Dressing Station will be established at OGHRETINA.

Transport.

No transport other than the camels for tations, water and forage and the sahd carts and sledges with the medical personnel will be taken.

Reports.

In addition to bringing all natives, reports will be furnished on the wells at all places passed through.

On completion of the reconnaissance, the Brigade will return to Camp. The provision of supplies for 1 meal and feed for July 14th is made in case it is necessary to stay out night of July 13/14th.

Reports will be sent to HILL 40.



In addition to the reconnaissance of the area round UMM AISHA (Square E.4 on 1/100,000 Map - QATIA) by the 1st L.H.Brigade (less 1 Regt) on July 12th, 13th and 14th, one Regiment, 2nd L.H.Brigade will leave Camp on the afternoon of the 12th instant and move with the 1st L.H.Brigade to OGHROTINA where it will bivouac for the night.

This Regiment will leave OGHROTINA at 0530 on the 13th and move to HOD EL KHIRBA and BIR ABU el AFEIN. One squadron will be employed at each of these places improving the existing water supply. The remaining squadron will be watching the country to the N and N E of BIR ABU el AFEIN.

On completion of the work, the Regiment will return to ET MALEH, marching in the cool of the evening.

- INFORMATION.** 1. Recent reports tend to show that there are a number of wandering Bedouins in the area bounded on the North by the SABIGHI IL BARDAWIL, and on the South by the road between KOD IL AMRAN and DIR IL ADD.
- INTENTION.** 2. It is intended to make a reconnaissance of this area (outlined in red on attached tracing) with the following objects -  
 (a) To systematically gather in such natives or flocks as may be in the area.  
 (b) To report on all roads and wells visited, and on the nature of the country generally.
- DATE.** 3. The reconnaissance will take place on Wednesday, 19th July, and Thursday, 20th July.
- TROOPS.** 4. For the reconnaissance - 2nd L.H. Brigade and attached Regiment, (less 5th and 12th L.H. Regiments).
- MOVES.** 5. (a) The Brigade will leave MMALER on the afternoon of Wednesday, 19th July so as to avoid moving in the heat of the day, and will march to OGHRIMINA.  
 (b) The Brigade, less escorts for Camels and Dressing Station, will leave OGHRIMINA at such an hour on the night 19/20th July as to arrive in the vicinity of BIR IL ADD at dawn. Two Regiments will then form a driving line to move westward with their left on the road at BIR IL ADD, and their right to move so as to include RAHAMA, and will drive towards and finally concentrate at OGHRIMINA, and will then withdraw to Camp under Brigade arrangements.  
 During the drive, the remaining Regiment will be used as covering troops on the BIR IL ADD road.  
 (c) One Squadron, 5th L.H. Regiment, will leave DULIDAR at such an hour as to arrive at HAMISH at dawn on the 20th July. They will watch the country to the South and East, and will not withdraw until the Brigade is concentrated at OGHRIMINA on the 20th.
- AMMUNITION.** 6. 140 rounds per man and 3,500 rounds per Machine Gun will be carried.
- SUPPLIES.** 7. One days ration and one iron ration per man, and two feeds for the horse will be carried. Camels conveying water and 2/3rds ration for men and 1 days forage for horses will accompany the Brigade to OGHRIMINA on the afternoon of the 19th.
- TRANSPORT.** 8. No transport other than the camels for the rations, water and forage, and the sand carts and sledges with the medical personnel will be taken.


