2. The functions of the Board will be to inspect the animals and all records thereof, of every Unit in the Divisional Group for the purpose of audit.

3. Units will receive 48 hours notice of the date the Board will visit them when A.P.W. 3852 and all books and vouchers relating to receipts, transfers, evacuations, sales, despatches to Base, and deaths will be produced.

4. The Audit Board will satisfy itself as to the accuracy of records of all animals since the return rendered on 1st Jan'y. 1919, vide G.R.O. 5908 of 24.12.18 and report thereon for the information of the Divl. Group Commander.

5. On the date the Board visits a unit the C.O. will furnish a certificate to the Board stating numbers of animals on charge at noon on that day.

ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS NO. 106

SPORTS GROUNDS.

In order to ensure that grounds are available for sport during the time troops are in BELGIUM units will reconnoitre suitable grounds and make arrangements for the period for which they will be required.

The following is the procedure when it is required to occupy any lands whatever.

Authority has been granted for occupation of areas up to 500 by 500 or 250,000 square yards for unit exercise and recreation.

(1) Select land and ascertain from owner or occupant if he is willing to have his land occupied.

(2) Make application to Div. H.Q. for authority to occupy stating in application:-

Name of owner or tenant.
Area of ground.
Map reference.
For what purpose required.

(3) The D.C.O. will then issue a "Certificate of occupation" for each piece of land occupied.

(4) These certificates are made out in triplicate and give a report on the condition of land, fences, gates etc.

(5) On finishing occupation the certificate is completed with a further report on condition of land, gates and fences etc.

(6) No arrangements whatever will be made with the owner as to amount of rent to be paid.

(7) Any unnecessary damage is chargeable against unit in occupation.

(8) The reports (vide paras 4 & 5) on condition of land are made by C. O. or his representative in Company with the civilian owner.

2500. OAT SACKS, RETURN OF TO ORDNANCE. Where necessary empty Oats Sacks may be used for the return of Ordnance Stores to the Base.
D.D.S. & T. will issue for this purpose 1000 sacks to each Corps, and to O.C. 4th ARMY Troops.
2501. TROPHIES. The Defense Department has reported that it is experiencing considerable embarrassment, through Officers writing to various Public Bodies in Australia and informing them that they are forwarding guns, etc. to them.
The attention of Units is drawn to A.I.F. Order 226 of 26th October 1917.
2502. REPAIR OF ROADS. Units are reminded of their responsibility for the repair of roads in their immediate vicinity and working parties are to be detailed forthwith.
2503. WEARING OF BELTS ETC. Other Belts will invariably wear web or leather belts or bandoliers according to branch of Service when on leave outside their own billeting area.
This order will be strictly enforced.
2504. EARLY REPATRIATES: DISCIPLINE. Personnel approved for "Early Repatriation who, after arrival at A.I.F. Depots in U.K. are "A.V.L." will, on completion of their punishment, be returned to their Units in France, their early repatriation being cancelled.
Further, they will not be permitted to make any special application thereafter.
2505. PAY. The usual fortnightly Pay of this Division will be available at the Div. Pay Office on Sunday next 23rd inst, between the hours 1900 and 1500.
Requisitions from Units should reach the Pay Office not later than 1200 on Thursday next 20th inst.

- 2512 MESSES. Attention is directed to G.R.O. 2000 which lays down that no expense can be allowed to fall on the public in consequence of the use of any portion of a building as an officer's, N.C.O's. or mens MESS.
Any Claim for rent, damages, gas, water or electricity in connection with a mess is therefore a matter for settlement by the individuals concerned, and formations are responsible that all such claims are settled immediately on vacation of the premises
- 2513 ARMY FORM W. 3852 A supply of this form (Monthly animal a/c) will be issued to all units. Steps will at once be taken to complete this form in every detail from 1st Jany. 1919, from the books and vouchers in possession of units. Every transaction is to be clearly shown in Chronological order.
- 2514 DISCIPLINE IN CHARLEROI. There has lately been certain cases of disorder in CHARLEROI and it is reported that generally men are in the Town without passes and after the hour laid down in G.R.O. 3718 9.30, p.m. - when all troops must be in their billets.
Whilst it is not desired to limit leave to CHARLEROI, steps will be taken forth-with to ensure that all men granted leave have a proper pass in their possession stamped with the Orderly Room Stamp and the date on which it is issued.
Army has been asked to extend the hour at which men must be in their billets, until 10.p.m. Until this is approved all W.O's., N.C.O's and men except those on duty or with special passes must be out of CHARLEROI by 9.30, p.m.
The A.P.M. has been instructed to check all men in the town without passes, or after 9.30 p.m.
- 2515 KILLING OF GAME IN BELGIUM. Special attention is drawn to Army Order 2907. Units will institute special patrols to ensure the observation of this order.
- 2516 ORDERS. Attention is drawn to the following orders:-
G.R.O. 5509 Officers of Overseas Forces, Army of the RHINE.
" 5513 Discipline, Escapes from Arrest
" 5514 Leave in Enemy Territory occupied by British.
- 2517 TRAFFICKING IN GOVERNMENT PROPERTY. In order to minimise the trafficking with civilians, in any of the following Government Stores - i.e., Jackets, Pantaloon, Breeches, Trousers, Pattes, Boots and Blankets - the Corps Commander directs that the following instructions will come into force forthwith.
In future units drawing any of these articles from Ordnance to replace unserviceable must return 100% of unserviceable articles.
Strict Accounts will be kept by D.A.D.C.O.S. of all issues to and receipts from Units during each month.

In order that Units may complete their returns of unserviceable articles before the end of the month, no issues of any of these items will be made, except to meet special urgent cases, during the last week of each month.

O.S.C. of Units which fail to return the full 100% unserviceable during the month in which the new stores are drawn, or to account satisfactorily for the deficiencies, will be charged full value for all deficiencies.

Underclothing will continue to be exchanged as previously through the Baths and Clothing Exchanges.

O.S.C. Units must exercise very careful supervision over demands for and issues of stores which have ready sale to civilians, such as soap, soda, oils, etc

2519. LEAVE TO COLOGNE.

1. The only leave to COLOGNE which may be granted at the present time is for 6 Officers weekly, the allotment of which to Units and instructions under which it is granted, being set out in 1st Aust. Divn. 104/1/19 of 6.3.19 and 4th Aust. Divn. AL/10/7 of 5.3.19.

2. It is reported that certain Officers and men of the Corps are visiting COLOGNE without leave, and in consequence, a provost party has been sent to COLOGNE to arrest all Officers and men found there without leave.

3. Units will at once take steps to prevent this visiting of the Rhine towns without leave, and will publish orders forbidding it, and severely punish all offenders.

4. It must be understood that this visiting of these towns without leave is jeopardising the success of the efforts now being made to obtain permission for increased numbers of Officers and parties of other Ranks to visit COLOGNE.

2520. MEDICAL. In future, no men will be despatched to the Base Depot, HAVRE, for the purpose of being medically boarded.

2521. SERVICES FOR PERSONNEL OF JEWISH FAITH. The Rev. J. DANGLON, M.A., Jewish Chaplain to the A.I.F., has made preliminary arrangements for the services for personnel of the Jewish Faith in PARIS, and the observance of the Passover. The Rev. DANGLON is arranging the necessary accommodation. Units will arrange to submit applications from members of the Jewish Faith for 9 days leave to PARIS, commencing 14.4.19.


