

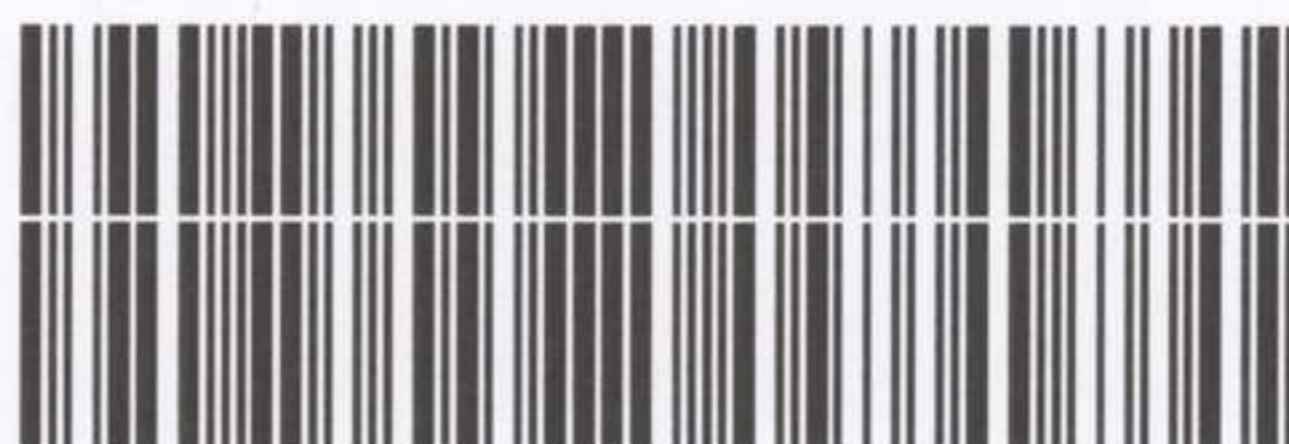

During the last 3 months of 1917 the Headquarters Instructional Staff at Moascar Training Centre changed considerably .

Major ALAN LOVE proceeded to H.Q. Desert Mounted Corps to take up a Staff Appointment , and his place was taken by Major R.F. WELLS , D.S.O , 15th. Hussars . More Imperial Army Instructors were appointed , and by the New Year 1918 the Establishment sanctioned by the War Office embraced 6 British Officers and 2 Australian Officers , also 24 N.C.Os (2 British - 19 Australian - and 3 New Zealand.) The above makes up the H.Q. Instructional Staff . In addition to this , each Brigade at the Front sends 8 Officers and 38 N.C.Os as a Training Cadre to their Training Regiment here . These are relieved every 3 months by others .

The system of keeping all recruits in an Isolation Camp whilst undergoing training has been found to produce very good results . To explain more fully the 4 Light Horse Training Regts., and the N.E.M.R. Training Regt. occupy the Main Moascar Camp , whereas the Isolation Camp is occupied by all recruits from Overseas . No recruit is allowed to join his Unit in the Main Camp until he has completely passed a full Course of Training , consisting of Musketry - Bayonet Fighting - Rifle Range - Marching - Anti-Gas Instruction - Riding School & Troop Drill . This procedure holds good to-day 22/2/18 .

There have been as many as 800 recruits under instruction at the same time in this Camp , and to collect the necessary numbers of Instructors has not been easy .

The Mounted Training Squadron numbering about 140 horses is commanded by Capt. T.B. FARGHER 5th. L.H. with a Staff of N.C.Os , the whole under the instructional control of Capt. T. LAWRENCE V.C., 18th. Hussars , and Capt. B.J.L. BANKS 15th. Hussars . Owing to the large numbers of recruits and scarcity of horses , it has not been found possible to allow more than a fortnight's Riding Instruction to each 140 recruits . In this short time the men are kept at work for a full 10 hours daily , and besides learning all that it is possible to teach them about Riding and Jumping - Troop Drill and Dismounted Action , they are also taught the correct system of Stables , including Grooming - Saddle Cleaning - Saddle Fitting - Feeding and Watering of Horses . Daily lectures are given by competent Instructors on all these subjects . A small percentage of the backward recruits are kept back for the next fortnight .

In the Main Camp - each of the Training Regiment has a few horses of its own , but the numbers of these are much reduced owing to the shortage of "B" Class horses available . Training is carried on in the same way as in the Isolation Camp , but cannot be centralized, ~~in the same way~~ , and Guards and Fatigues upset the continuity of training .

The Cadre N.C.Os on arrival at Moascar are put through a N.C.Os' Class lasting 3 weeks , before they commence instructing recruits - This has been found to be very necessary , and to still further improve the training , the permanent Instructional Staff has lately (Feb.) been increased to 36 N.C.Os .

Training in the Main Camp consists in refreshing in the various subjects , such as Musketry - Bayonet Fighting - Physical Drill - Gas & Simple Topography - men who have been recently wounded or sick and arrived at Moascar on discharge from Hospital.

Each Training Regiment now has a Special Musketry Instructor , and everything is done to try and make the training bright and interesting to the men whilst they have to be here .

There is also the Machine Gun Training Squadron with its Establishment of Training Cadre Officers & N.C.Os , through which Unit all men belonging to the M.G. Corps have to pass after discharge from Hospital . Reinforcements for this Corps have been practically nil since October 1917 , and quite a number of men (recruits) had to be transferred from the various Regiments to keep the Machine Gun Squadrons in the Field up to strength .

Other Units run on much the same lines as above are the :-
A.A.M.C. - A.A.S.C. - A.A.V.C. - & P.Sqdn. Engrs .

Special 10 day Hotchkiss Rifle classes are regularly held. All N.C.Os and men on arriving here from Hospital have , when sufficiently fit, ~~to~~ to fire the "Trained Soldiers" Course of Musketry on the Range . In constant use also are the Field Firing Range and the Machine Gun Ranges .

Authority has been received to open a Cookery School and Farriry School , both of which will shortly commence .

Once a month , N.C.Os and men are sent up to the Zeitoun Schools , to undergo a stiff Course of Musketry - or Bayonet Fighting - or Vickers Gun - or Hotchkiss Rifle - Only the most intelligent and keen N.C.Os and men are sent , and the results have been very gratifying - Australia & New Zealand both regularly coming out very much on top , from amongst the other Army candidates . From earliest days this Training Centre has received every possible assistance from the Staff of the Zeitoun Schools ; whilst making many useful training suggestions to us , they have always been ready to meet us in every way . For this excellent co-operation thanks are largely due to Lieut. Colonel E.M. COLSTON , The Commandant in 1916 , and Colonel de PUTRON, the present Commandant .

The number of recruits under instruction has now at the end of February 1918, fallen so low , that unless more arrive here from Overseas at once , all will be fully trained and the work will have to be divided into (1) refresher courses in selected subjects for some , and (2) more advanced training - tactical exercises in the Field etc., for others ; with shortage of horses , the hot weather beginning and deep sand everywhere , this will not be easy.
