Gollan reports as follows :- I left camp at 0800 in charge of a patrol of 1 Sergeant and 14 ORanks with instructions to proceed to KR-ES-SUTUHIYA where I was to meet an Egyptian Police Officer and to assist him to enforce law and order I arrived at KR-ES-SUTUHIYA at 1000, and at 1200 the police officer Mohammed-Ali-El-Hafuawi arrived from DIVABR-NIGM. He informed me that he wanted three men from the villiage, whom the Omda had previously refused to hand over. We found the Omda, and told him we wanted the three men. I left ZAGAZIG at 0800 on the 7<sup>th</sup> to investigate the charges. I had the seven natives brought before me and then searched their houses but found nothing of an incriminating nature. I was assisted by the Omda of this village who was most obliging. After having the propoganda posted up in the village of BENI ESHBEL. I visited the following villages and had the same thing done:- TELLHAWIN KR NAUWAR, KR EDDIER ET TALLIEN, MAGAMIS, EL WALAGA ESHSHAQR EL AZIZIA. I camped for the night 7/8 May at MINET EL PAMH &amp; returned to ZAGAZIG by the main railway, and visited the following villages:- EL GUDEIYIDA, MIT BASMAR, EZ ZANKALUN and SHARWIDA. Had the pamphlets posted in all of these villages. The natives appeared to be more friendly than I have yet seen them, and appeared more pleased than otherwise to see the patrol.
