AUSTRALIAN CORPS ORDER NO. 135.

1. (a) The 58th Division of the III Corps will relieve the 5th Australian Division in the line in "C" Divisional Sector north of K.l.d. 5.3. on the night 27/28th July, 1918.

On completion of the relief the inter-Corps Boundary will be as shown on the attached map west to C.24.a.0:0. thence west as at present.

(b) Consequent on (a)

(i) 47th Heavy Artillery Brigade (8") will be taken over by III Corps in its present positions.

(ii) 86th Army Brigade, R.F.A. in "A" Divisional Sector will change over with 6th Aust. Army Brigade A.F.A. in "C" Divisional Sector, to be completed by 10 a.m. on 27th July.

Guns will be taken over in situ. Details will be arranged between Divisions.

86th Army Brigade, R.F.A. will be transferred to III Corps.

(iii) 5th Brigade, R.H.A., will be transferred to III Corps in its present positions.

(iv) 23rd Army Brigade, R.F.A., will be transferred from "B" Division to "C" Division on night 27/28th July, under arrangements to be made between Divisions concerned.

(c) Command will pass to III Corps at 10 a.m. on 28th July.

(d) The Australian Corps will continue the work now being carried out on BAIZIEUX Line in the part handed over to III Corps.

Subject to the above details will be arranged between Divisions concerned. CRA

2. (i) The 4th Australian Division (less Artillery, but including H.Q. 4th Australian Divisional Artillery) will relieve the 5th Australian Division (less Artillery, but including Headquarters, 5th Australian Divisional Artillery) in "C" Divisional Sector on the nights 27/28th and 28/29th July, 1918.

(ii) Reliefs will be carried out under order of the G.O.C., 5th Australian Division.

(iii) Command will pass at 10 a.m. 29th July, 1918.

On completion of relief Headquarters of 4th and 5th Australian Divisions will be at ST. GRATIEN and COISY respectively and the following Artillery will come under the orders of the G.O.C., 4th Australian Division :-

5th Australian Divisional Artillery,
4th Australian Divisional Artillery,
23rd Army Brigade, R.F.A.

3. (i) The line of demarcation for counter battery work between the Australian and III Corps will be the grid line running E. and W. through K.l.d.0.0.

(ii) The 9th Brigade, R.G.A., now affiliated to the 5th Australian Division will become affiliated to the 4th Australian Division on completion of relief.

4. (1) On relief the 5th Australian Division will move into Reserve, the brigade groups occupying areas vacated by Brigade groups of the 4th Australian Division with nucleus garrison battalions disposed as laid down in Instructions for the Defensive No.57 of 17th July, 1918. One Batta of the Rivery Bde will be located at VAUX.

(ii) The relief of the Brigade group located in the RIVERY - CAMON Area will be effected by bus under arrangements to be made by "C" Australian Corps.

5. G.O.C., 5th Australian Division will take over from G.O.C., 4th Australian Division the orders and responsibilities allotted to the Division in Corps Reserve (Instructions for Defensive No.57 of 17th July 1918, and para 4 of Defensive Instructions No.49.)

6. (1) Defence Schemes, defence works policy and programme and all divisional details of the second zone defences will be handed over to the 5th Australian Division by the 4th Australian Division.

(ii) The responsibility for the demolition of roads and bridges will be handed over in accordance with the tables issued under Instructions for Defensive No.55 of 9th July, 1918.

7. Units of the 65th American Brigade attached to "C" Divisional Area vide G.138/1872 of 16th July will come under the command of G.O.C. 4th Australian Division on completion of relief; any personnel of 5th Australian Division attached will be relieved by 4th Australian Division.

8. Administrative, Engineer, and Medical Instructions are being issued separately.

9. Subject to the terms of this order arrangements for the relief will be made direct between Divisional Commanders concerned.

The G.O.C., 5th Australian Division will assume command of all relieving troops in "C" Divisional Area until command passes.

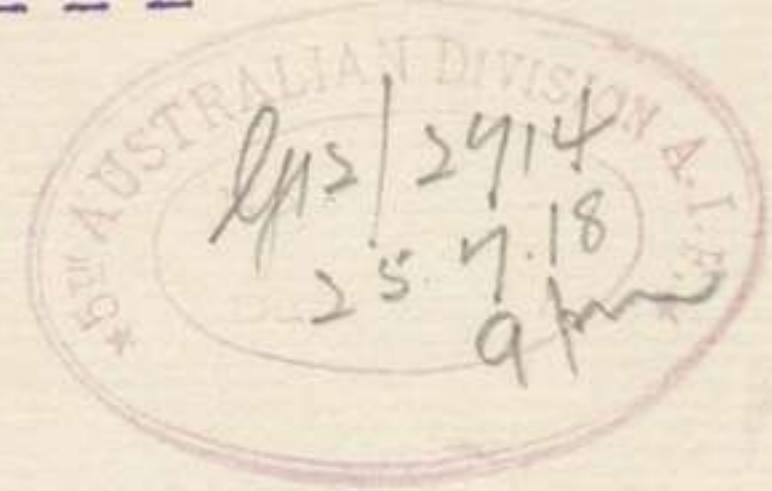

1. (a) The 58th Division of the III Corps will relieve the 5th Australian Division in the line in "C" Divisional sector north of K.l.d.6.3. on the night 27/28th July 1918.
On completion of the relief the inter-divisional boundary will be as shown on the attached map west to C.24.a.O.O., thence west as at present.
 - (b) Consequent on (a)
 - (i) 47th Heavy Artillery Brigade (8") will be taken over by III Corps in its present positions.
 - (ii) 86th Army Brigade, R.F.A., in "A" Divisional sector will change over with 6th Aust. Army Brigade A.F.A. in "C" Divisional sector, to be completed by 10 a.m. on 27th July.
Guns will be taken over in situ. Details will be arranged between C.R.A's concerned.
86th Army Brigade R.F.A. will be transferred to III Corps.
 - (iii) 5th Brigade R.H.A. will be transferred to III Corps in its present positions.
 - (iv) 23rd Army Brigade R.F.A. will be transferred from "B" Division to "C" Division on night 27/28th July, under arrangements to be made between C.R.A's concerned.
 - (c) Command will pass to III Corps at 10 a.m. on 28th July.
 - (d) The Australian Corps is to continue the work now being carried out on BAIZIEUX Line in the part handed over to III Corps.
- Subject to the above, details will be arranged between Divisions concerned.
2. (a) The 4th Australian Division (less Artillery, but including H.Q. 4th Australian Divisional Artillery) will relieve the 5th Australian Division (less Artillery, but including Headquarters, 5th Australian Divisional Artillery) in "C" Divisional Sector on the nights 27/28th and 28/29th July 1918.
 - (b) Reliefs will be carried out under orders of the G.O.C. 5th Australian Division.
 - (c) Command will pass at 10 a.m. 29th July 1918.
On completion of relief Headquarters of 4th and 5th Australian Divisions will be at St. GRATIEN and ALLONVILLE respectively and the following Artillery will come under the orders of the G.O.C. 4th Australian Division:-
 - 5th Australian Divisional Artillery
 - 4th Australian Divisional Artillery
 - 23rd Army Brigade, R.F.A.
3. (a) The line of demarcation for counter battery work between the Australian and III Corps will be the grid line running E and W. through K.l.d.O.O.
 - (b) The 9th Brigade R.G.A. now affiliated to the 5th Australian Division will become affiliated to the 4th Australian Division on completion of relief.
4. (a) On relief the 5th Australian Division will come into Reserve, the Brigade groups occupying areas to be vacated by Brigade Groups of the 4th Australian Division will nucleus garrison battalions disposed as laid down in 5th Aust. Div. Instructions for the Defensive No. 5 of 25th July 1918. One Battalion of the Rivery Brigade will be located at VAUX-en-AMIENOIS.

(b) The relief of the Brigade group located in the RIVER Y-CAMON area is to effected by bus under arrangements to be made by the Administrative Branch of the Staff.

5. G.O.'s.C. Brigade 5th Australian Division will take over from G.O.'s.C. Brigades 4th Australian Division the orders and responsibilities allotted to the Brigades in Corps Reserve.

6. (a) Defence Schemes, defence works policy and programme and all divisional details of the defences will be handed over.

(b) The responsibility for the demolition of roads and bridges will be handed over in accordance with the tables issued.

7. Units of the 65th American Brigade attached to "C" Divisional Area vide G188/1872 of 16th July will come under command of G.O.C. 4th Australian Division on completion of relief; personnel of 5th Australian Division attached will be relieved by 4th Australian Division and will return to units under arrangements to be made by (a) "Q" Div.

8. Relief of Infantry Brigades will take place in accordance with the attached table of reliefs and moves. (b) Divisional Engineers and Pioneer Battalion will be relieved under arrangements to be made by C.R.E. Instructions for the relief of 5th Machine Gun Battalion and Medical Units will be issued by C.O. 5th Machine Gun Battalion and A.D.M.S. respectively. Administrative arrangements are being issued separately.

9. Subject to the terms of this order arrangements for the relief will be made direct between C.K.A's and Brigade Commanders concerned. The G.O.C. 5th Australian Division will assume command of all relieving troops in "C" Divisional Area until command passes.

10. 5th Australian Divisional Headquarters will close at St. GRAT IEN at 10 a.m. on 29/7/18 and will open at the same hour at ALLONVILLE Chateau.

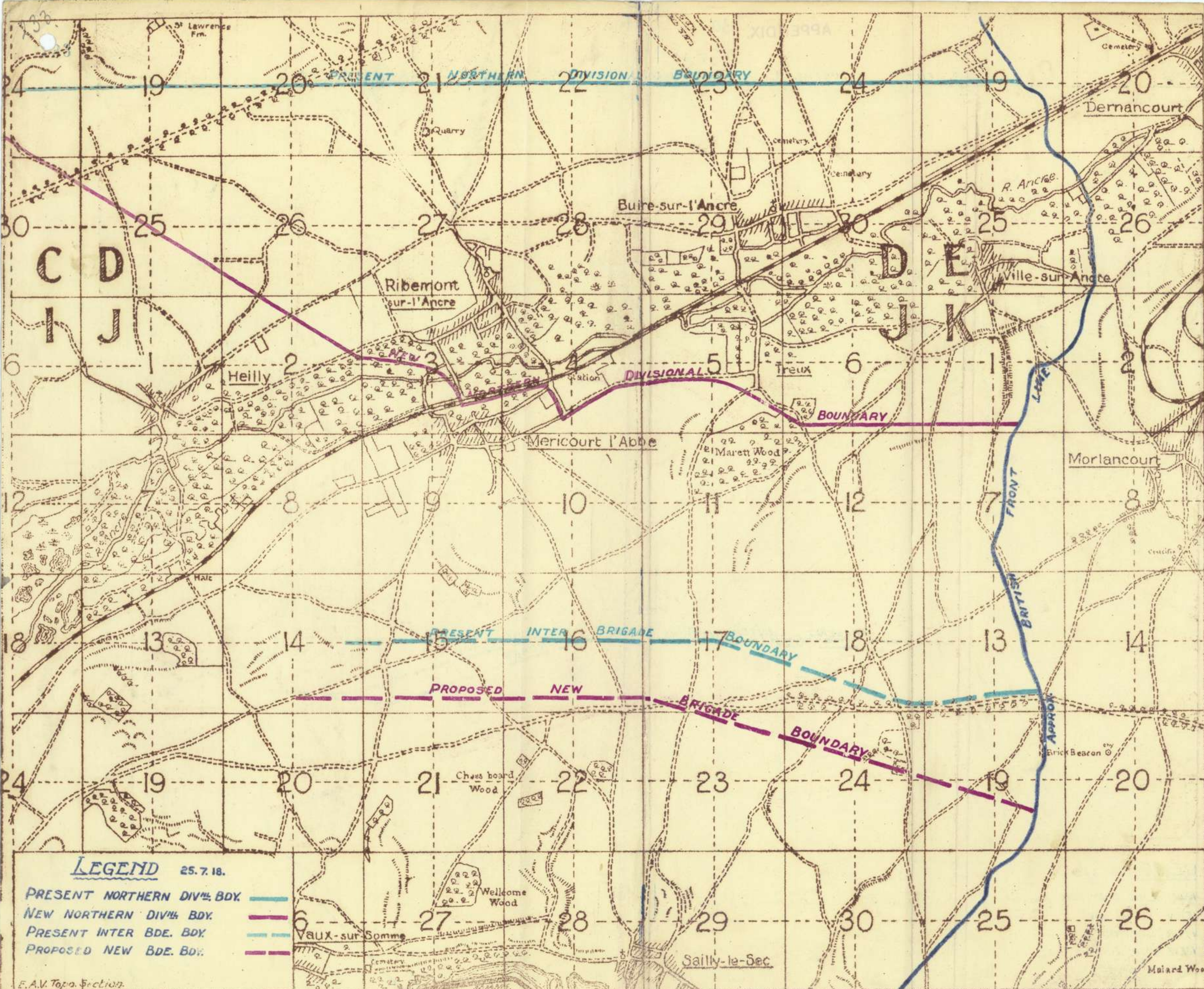

1. The Boundaries between the 58th Division and the 47th Division on the Left and the 5th Australian Division on the Right will be altered on the nights July 26th/27th and July 27th/28th respectively.
2. (a) On the night 26th/27th the 47th Division will extend its right as far South as the line E.8.a.3.2. - E.7.b.8.0. (BANK ST. inclusive to 58th Division) - thence West along the Grid bearing to D.7.a.0.0. - thence N.W. to C.6.d.4.4. - thence due West.
(b) Units of 175th Infantry Brigade North of above line will be relieved by 142nd Infantry Brigade and two Companies 173rd Infantry Brigade in LAVIEVILLE Line by 141st Infantry Brigade.
(c) The same night the 174th Infantry Brigade will extend its left and relieve the 175th Infantry Brigade as far North as the above mentioned line, which will then become the Northern Divisional Boundary.
Command will pass in both cases on completion of relief.
3. On completion of relief the 175th Infantry Brigade will be accommodated as under :-

1 Battalion	...	BAIZIEUX.
2 Battns. (less 2 Coys.)	...	BOIS ROBERT.
2 Companies	...	LAVIEVILLE LINE, between Northern Divl. Boundary and ALBERT -AMIENS Road.
4. On the night July 27th/28th the 173rd Infantry Brigade will relieve the 8th Australian Infantry Brigade from the present Southern Divisional Boundary as far South as the Line K.l.d.5.3. - N.E. corner of MARETT WOOD (J.6.c.2.3.) - J.5.c.2.7. - thence by road to J.4.c.9.2. - J.4.c.6.7. - J.3.d.4.5. - J.3.b.0.2. (Road inclusive to 58th Division) - thence due West to J.3.a.0.0. - thence N.W. to C.24.a.0.0. - thence West along the Grid bearing.
This line will then become the Southern Divisional Boundary.
Command of the area taken over will pass from 5th Australian Division to 58th Division at 10 a.m. 28th July, 1918.
5. Moves will take place in accordance with the attached Table "A".
6. All details will be arranged direct between B.G's.C concerned.
7. (a) The Artillery covering the portion of the front taken over from the 5th Australian Division (2 Army Field Artillery Brigades, 1 Heavy Brigade 8" Howitzers) will be handed over in situ under orders to be issued later by G.O.C. R.A. III Corps.
(b) The necessary re-distribution of Artillery entailed by the change of the Northern Divisional Boundary will be made under orders to be issued later by G.O.C., R.A. III Corps.

- 8. The re-distribution of R.E. Companies will be made direct between the C's.R.E. concerned.
- 9. O.C. 58th Bn. M.G.C. will arrange direct with O's.C. 47th Bn. M.G.C. and 5th Australian Bn. M.G.C. for the relief of the Machine Guns in the new areas.
The Company of 2nd (Life Guards) Bn. Guards M.G. Regt. now in BAIZIEUX Line will be employed in defences in and West of LAVIEVILLE - TASMANIAN Line under orders from O.C. 58th Bn. M.G.C.
