

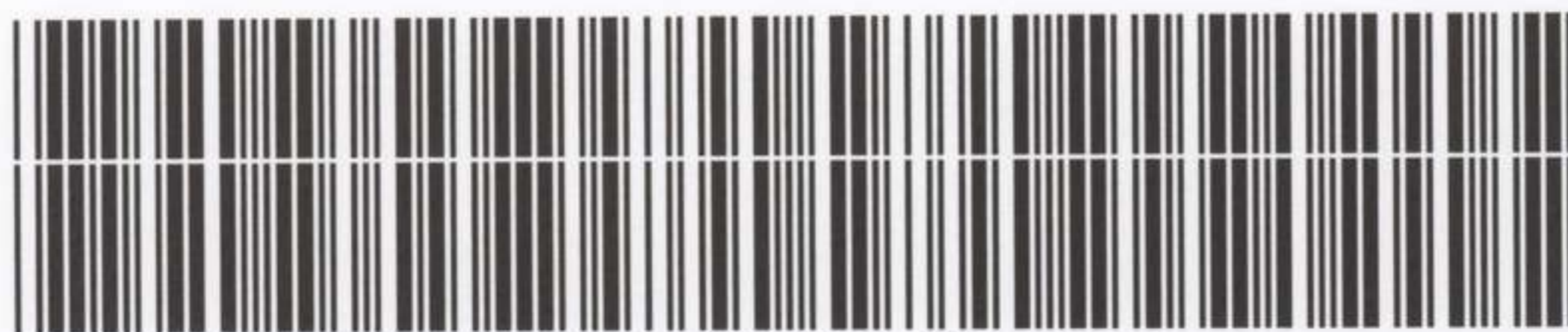

Reference your Ga 6 of today, from the wording of para 10 of the instructions referred to I took it that the patrols from whom reports were required were those usually sent out from the front trenches.



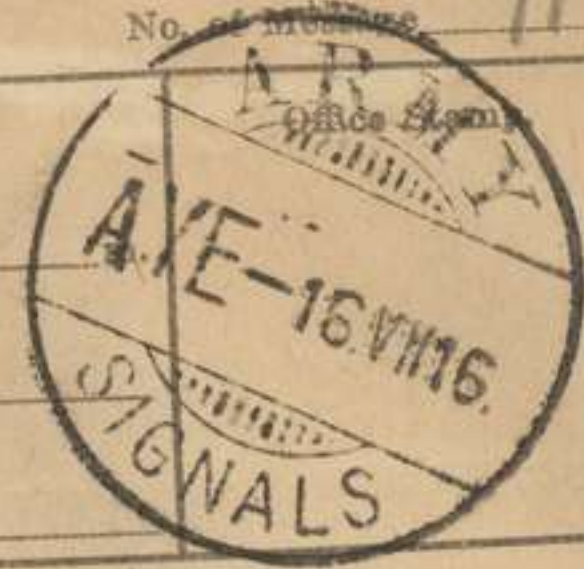

MEMORANDUM:

1. It seems very necessary that troops in the front line should be instructed in immediately withdrawing to the flanks from a portion of trench which is being heavily and definitely bombarded, even if this means going through the sides of a box barrage.
2. The G.O.C. suggests that it might be well for patrols to go out with blackened faces and hands, and even without distinguishing marks or documents. Distinguishing numbers could be given to them for the time being.
3. The systems of periscope observation to be organized in the trenches, of observation, and of patrolling are of no use unless the observations are collated and recorded. This work will go on after the intended assault, and in the course of a few days units, and formations should be in possession of good maps and should have a thorough knowledge of the 'NO MAN'S LAND' between us and the enemy's trenches.

1. Owing to some of our lines having been cut last night to allow the passage of our attacking tanks it will be necessary tonight to watch the gaps carefully and possibly close some of them up again temporarily.

2. Front line parapets, when damaged by recent enemy shell fire must be repaired tonight sufficiently to make them defensible.

3. Particular care must be taken this evening to ensure that battalion commanders left in charge of the sections of the front line are in close touch with the Artillery Group commander in charge of their front. In the case of enemy bombardment or attack retaliatory fire or barrage fire must be asked for promptly.

4. GOC would like to know whether any fire asked for is given promptly or acknowledge.

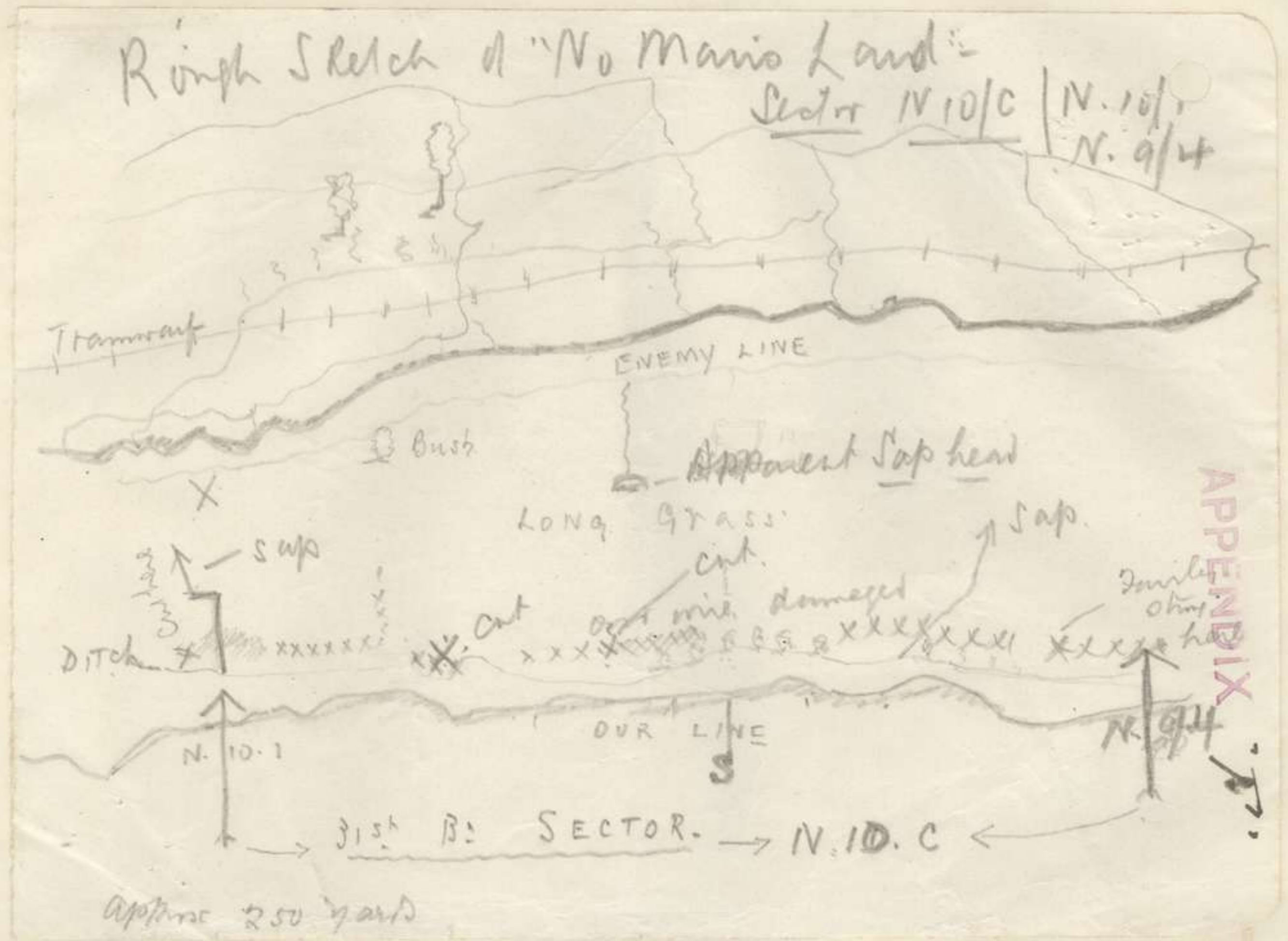

Second Army.

O.B. 492

1. Several cases have occurred recently of the enemy developing a concentrated fire of gas shells of a type not hitherto experienced, namely, containing a gas of which the effect is directly poisonous and even fatal, and not greatly lachrymatory.

2. Owing to the small explosion which occurs with these shells they are liable to be mistaken for blinds, and even when the gas is smelt men are liable not to realise its dangerous character ^{at once and to delay putting on respirators or helmets} till too late. Men sleeping in dug-outs may be seriously affected before they are roused.

3. The following points should be brought to the notice of all units, and particularly of the artillery:-

- (a) That respirators or helmets must be at all times immediately available to all ranks within artillery range.
- (b) That all shells which explode with a small detonation or appear to be blind should be regarded with particular attention and the helmet or respirator put on at the first indication of gas.
- (c) That men in the open air are unlikely to be seriously affected by gas shells provided they put on helmets or respirators on experiencing the gas, whereas men in dugouts or shelters may be overcome unless they receive timely warning of its approach. The latter is particularly the case during the night.
- (d) It is therefore absolutely necessary that a sentry should be posted at every dug-out or group of dug-outs to give warning of gas shells. This applies to artillery and other units behind the trench line in the same way as to units in the trenches.
- (e) It is desirable that artillery and other units not already provided with instruments for sounding the alarm should arrange for the provision of gongs, rails, etc. for this purpose.
- (f) Dug-outs not already provided with double blanket protection to the entrances should be fitted up in this manner wherever it is possible. The next duty of the sentry after sounding the alarm should be to see that all curtains are let down.
- (g) It should be clearly understood that the P.H. and P.H.G. Helmets and the box respirator give complete protection against all poisonous shell gases.

4. The question is one of extreme importance and urgency and immediate orders on the subject must be issued. Special care must be taken to impress on all ranks absolute confidence in the protections afforded if the orders are strictly observed.


