Herewith report on working of Australian Dental Clinic,
1st Australian Convalescent Depot, Havre, for month ending 27th July,1918.

General. Work has been proceeding steadily during the month, although
during the last fortnight there has not been a great deal of work
presenting. This is due to the fact that the drafts of men
marching into C8n. Depot have not been very large and at the
same time only a very moderate percentage of these patients have
