MOASCAR	31	V.D.	<p>The health of the Troops during the month under review has, on the whole, been good. The influenza epidemic has considerably decreased and the number of men coming up for quinine treatment shows an appreciable decrease. There has been a marked falling off in the number of IX cases sent to No. 2 A.S. Hospital for treatment, and only one case of Infectious Disease, (Measles) was contracted.</p> <p>The monthly Medical Classification Board was held at Moascar on the 11th. inst. when five Officers & 169 O/Ranks were classified.</p> <p>Reinforcements ex "MAIFA" which arrived on 22nd. inst. were sent direct to Central Tfg. Depot for period of quarantine, a considerable number of cases of influenza having been contracted on the voyage over from Australia, and On arrival they were admitted to Hospital at Suez. The troops in quarantine are mostly young men of poor physique. The A.A.M.C. personnel comprised 4 S/Sgts. and 16 O/Ranks, all of whom are undergoing the customary training, and equitation instruction will follow preparatory to their marching out to A.A.M.C. Tfg. Unit.</p> <p>The sanitation of the Camp has been good, and there has been a marked diminution in the number of flies. The quality of the food has been up to the standard.</p>
