1. (1) The 8th Corps is to attack the Turkish trenches on portion of their front to-day, commencing at 0730.  
(ii) The A & N.Z. Army Corps has been instructed to engage the enemy's attention and to prevent reinforcements leaving the area in front of that Corps.
2. The 2nd L.H. Bde will 1 by the following demonstration and movement engage the enemy's attention:-
  - (i) 6th & 7th L.H. Regts will at 0730 strengthen their garrison on HOLLY SPUR to 100 men each.
  - (ii) Covering parties of 1 troop each will be sent out at 0755 and will drive back any enemy's covering party confronting them. The covering parties will be withdrawn to the forward trenches on HOLLY SPUR at 0815.
  - (iii) "At 0815 at a signal (flag) from head of communication trench leading from "C" Squadron tunnel (7th L.H.) into HOLLY SPUR TRENCH 6th & 7th L.H. Regts will by passing well extending successive lines over the parapet of existing trenches into the trenches of HOLLY SPUR simulate an attack. These men as they pass into trenches on HOLLY SPUR may be withdrawn via by the tunnels and covered approaches. Troops from 6th L.H. will be withdrawn by "C" Squadron tunnel 7th L.H. and those from 7th L.H. by "B" Squadron tunnel, 7th L.H. A signal will be made for each successive line to advance over the parapet.
  - (iv) At the same time as in (iii) these Regts will by movement, noise in the trenches, showing bayonets, dummies, and by short bursts of rifle fire from HOLLY SPUR TRENCHES simulate all the preparations for an attack towards PINE RIDGE and ECHELON TRENCHES.
  - (v) O/C 5th L.H. Regt will by similar measures to (iv) above simulate all the preparations for an attack towards ECHELON TRENCHES and TWIN TRENCHES from CHATHAMS POST.
3. In the event of the enemy bombarding our trenches troops not employed in above demonstration and movement will be placed under cover.
