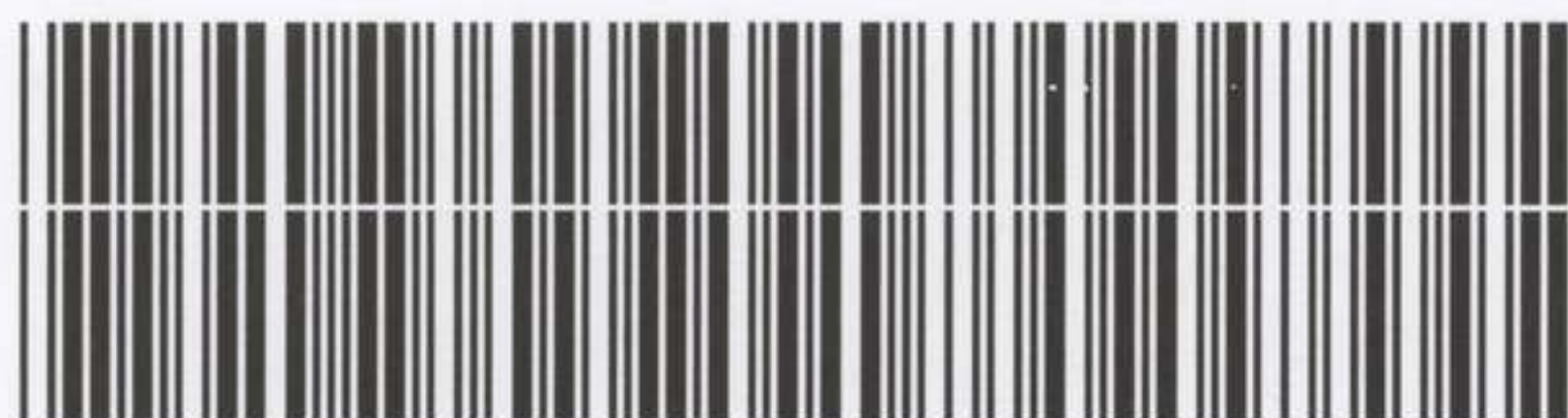

C.H.Wm.HARDY. V.D. from C.O. 6th Aust. Field Ambulance.<br/>D.A.D.M.S. Major H.H.B. FOLLIT.</p> <p>For the period under review very little definite data is available concerning the organising of the medical units of the Division, and the administration of the Division.</p> <p>During the latter end of February, and early in March the nucleus of the various units which were to form the 5th Australian Division were concentrated at TEL-EL-KEBIR. At this time Lt. COLONEL. G.W.BARBER. carried out the duties of A.D.M.S. Aust. Provisional Formations and 4th Australian Division, whilst Lt. Colonel C.H.Wm.HARDY. V.D. was A.D.M.S. 5th Australian Division. Each A.D.M.S. was responsible for the supervision of the sanitation of the Areas occupied by the units of their respective Divisions. The northern portion of the camp being that of the 4th Aust. Division, and the southern that of the 5th Aust.
