

			For the period under review very little definite data is available concerning to the organising of the medical units of the Division, and the administration of the Division.  During the latter end of February, and early in March the nucleus of the various units which were to form the 5th Australian Division were concentrated at TEL-EL-Kebir.  At this time Lt. COLONEL. G.W.BARBER. carried out the duties of A.D.M.S. Aust. Provisional Dormations and 4th Australian Division, whilst Lt. Colonel C.H.Wm.HARDY. V.D. was A.D.M.S.
