

#### Artillery.

0515 Enemy gums fired four shrapnel shells at N.E. patrol.

O630 Heavier calibre gun fired from slopes of EL HAUD. This gun Has been distinctly seen on several occasions but owing to the inaccuracy of the maps co-ordinates are useless.

0800 East patrol shelled by same gum.

Our artillery shelled enemy in direction of UMM ESH SHERT, also fired three shells towards EL HAUD.

#### Attitude of Mnewy.

Rather more sniping than is usual at North patrols. After II50 very quiet.

#### Enemy Defences.

Enemy using emplosives in their trenches along foothills and were noticed at work practically all day.

No new works observed.

#### Enemy Movement.
