Mail for Australia closes at 8 p.m. every Sunday night.

Letters addressed 18 cally are delivered free, those for other countries must be stamped. If no stamps are available letters to be so marked. Presents to friends in Australia from members of the Expeditionary Forces are admitted free of duty. Notification of Registered Letters at Field Post Office will be sent to individuals concerned who must claim and sign for them in person; or send written authority.

A branch of the Egyptian Post Office is established in the Camp opposite Mena House for the sale of stamps & registration of outgoing mail. "
