2. The Postal Duties for Mena Camp have been taken over from First Australian Division by the Field Post Office 3rd Light Horse Brigade.


A Postal Orderly from each unit will be appointed to attend at the Field Post Office, which is situated at the corner of Infantry and Canberra roads at 10 am & 5 p.m. each day, for the receipt and return of mails. The Orderly should be a man well acquainted with the personnel of his unit, and every effort should be made to trace addressees. Letters for that particular unit should be so marked and returned to Field Post Office at next time of call for receiving mails. Letters will be delivered to none but the recognised postal orderly.

There are generally three mails from Australia per month.

Mail for Australia closes at 8 p.m. every Sunday night.

Letters addressed locally are delivered free, those for other countries must be stamped. If no stamps are available letters to be so marked. Presents to friends in Australia from members of the Expeditionary Forces are admitted free of duty. Notification of Registered Letters at Field Post Office will be sent to individuals concerned who must claim and sign for them in person; or send written authority.

A branch of the Egyptian Post Office is established in the Camp opposite Mena House for the sale of stamps & registration of outgoing mail. "




