SALHIA SUB MECTOR. Situation quiet. On night of 1/2nd a revolver shot was fired at the sentry on AKIAD Station. He fired back, but the man escaped in the darkness. The Omdah of AKIAD and EL MANAGAT EL KUBRA, seem to have very little control over their districts.

ZAGAZIG SUB SECTOR. Situation all quiet. 7 Agitators deported from ZAGAZIG.

MANSURA SUB SECTOR. Situation all quiet. Cases disposed of by Military Court 6.

# #4-- ZAGAZIG SECTOR ORDER NO. 7 ----

(1) The following moves will take place with a view to early embarkation for AUSTRALIA:-
