13th January, 1918.

During the past three months the Brigade has been called upon for special effort in the line and it is now my desire to express my appreciation to all ranks for their continued noble responses to the demands made upon them, especially during the period October 31st to January 11th.

The captures for the Division amounted to 88 Officers, 1854 O.R's., 35 guns and 8 machine guns; of these the Brigade is responsible for 60 Officers, 1258 O.R's. and ~~12~~ ² machine guns, a percentage of the total guns which bears eloquent testimony to the manner in which all ranks carried out their arduous duties.

To my Staff I tender my thanks for their loyal support and untiring effort under the most adverse circumstances.

The gallant conduct of the 4th and 12th Regiments at BEERSHEBA under Lieut-Colonel BOURCHIER D.S.O. and Lieut-Colonel D. CAMERON D.S.O. has been recognised by H.M. the KING in the form of honours conferred; thus rendering impotent any praise I might ~~offer~~ confer.

The speedy and brilliant way the Brigade came into action at TURMUS after a most strenuous period of fighting reflects the highest credit on all ranks units, as does also the tenacity displayed by all ranks at SHERIA against greatly superior numbers of the enemy.

All regiments have done consistently good work and with the co-operation of the Machine Gun Squadron, Field Troop, Signal Service and R.H.A. have succeeded in placing the Brigade upon a level with their far famed Australian Comrades in all theatres of the war.

I cannot too enthusiastically commend the work of those units of the R.H.A. which were placed at my disposal. At BEERSHEBA the Notts Battery under Major HARRISON and from SHERIA Northward "A" Battery H.A.C. under Major SMITH performed what in cold ink would read like the impossible.

The work of the Field Troop under Lieut. HARRISON entailed a series of self sacrifice and was ably conducted at all times.

The work of the Signal Service has been exceptionally well and energetically executed and in the main, almost without fault, though the conditions were necessarily extraordinary.

The Field Ambulance was called on for special exertion under the most adverse conditions, but at no time was the organisation and conduct of this unit under Major PARRY at fault. The untiring energy and competence of this unit has inspired me and my staff with the greatest confidence in its work.

The publication of the following casualty state causes me the deepest regret, light as they are in comparison to the Brigade's achievements.
