SCHEME OF EVACUATION

Cases are cleared from the battlefield to R.A.P's. by Regimental stretcher bearers; from R.A.P's by relays of Field Ambulance Bearers to Birr X Roads; thence lying cases by Divisional ambulance cars to Advanced dressing station for lying wounded, I.9.c.6.6. and walking wounded by motor bus or motor lorry to Advanced dressing station for walking wounded I.9.c.6.6.

C.O. C Aust Field Amb will make all possible use of light railways as they become available for evacuation of cases to Advanced dressing station.

From advanced dressing station cases are despatched by M.A.C. Cars or motor lorry to YPRES for conveyance to Casualty Clearing station. GODEWEARSVELDE by broad gauge train, or if no trains available direct to Casualty Clearing Station group at REMY SIDING.

A Field Ambulance Medical Officer is stationed at each of the following forward posts :-

J.7.a.3.2.

J.3.b.5.4.

Headquarters of C Aust Field Amb. is at Advanced Dressing Btn. I.9.c.6.6. (Stretcher and walking cases)

In the event of an advance, R.A.P's. will be established further forward by R.M.O's. and Field Ambulance Medical Officers will be stationed at J.4.b.9.1. and D.28.a.1.0.

C.O. C Aust Field Amb. has at advanced dressing station I.9.c.6.6. a number of guides. These guides will be supplied on demand to R.M.O's going forward, and are to be used as means of establishing communication between R.M.O's. and the nearest Field Ambulance Post.

A stock of stretchers, blankets, medical and surgical requisites and medical comforts is maintained at all R.A.P's. and Field Ambulance Posts. A large reserve stock is held at Corps Main Dressing Station.

1. In accordance with 2nd.Aust.Div. Order No.154 the 2nd.Aust. Division will be relieved by 49th.Division.
The following Medical Arrangements are made.
2. 5th.Aust.Field Amb. less Bearer Division, plus Bearer Division 6th.Aust.Field Amb., on relief by an Ambulance of 49th.Division on 8th.November 1917, will move to STEENVOORDE. C.O. 5th.Aust.Field Amb. will make arrangements direct with 5th.A.I.Brigade for collection of sick en route and whilst the 5th.A.I.Brigade is in STEENVOORDE Area 6th.Aust.Field Amb. Bearer Division will be relieved by a bearer division of 49th.Division R.A.H.C. and likewise the 5th. and 7th. Aust.Field Ambulances in turn.
3. 6th.Aust.Field Amb. less bearer division and plus bearer div. of 5th.Aust.Field Amb. will move to STEENVOORDE on 9th.November 1917. C.O.6th.Aust.Field Amb. will arrange direct with 7th.A.I.Brigade H.Q. for collection of sick en route and whilst the Brigade is in the STEENVOORDE Area.
5th. and 6th.Aust.Field Ambs. will re-adjust their Units on arrival in STEENVOORDE Area and the Units will be attached to 5th. and 7th.A.I.Brigades respectively until further notice.
4. 7th.Aust.Field Amb. on relief by an Ambulance of 49th.Division on 12th.inst. will move to WIPPENHOEK Area. C.O. 7th.Aust.Field Amb. will arrange with 6th.A.I.Brigade H.Q. for collection of sick en route and whilst the Brigade is in WIPPENHOEK Area.
5. Troops on the march will maintain distances as under West of YPRES and COMINES Canal
800 yards between units.
400 " " transport of units, horsed units and other troops.
200 yards between companies.
East of the Canal great care must be taken that troops move in small parties.
6. Ambulance Commanders will detail an officer and two other ranks to make necessary billeting arrangements with Area Commandant STEENVOORDE or WIPPENHOEK Areas, prior to the moves outlined.
7. Ambulance cars and Horse Transport of 5th.Aust.Field Amb. will report back to its Unit on 7-11-17.
Ambulance cars and Horse Transport of 6th.Aust.Field Amb. will report back to Unit on afternoon of 8th.inst.
8. Ambulance Commanders will notify this office at once of any surplus equipment which cannot be taken.
C.O. 6th.Aust.Field Amb. will establish a dump at RENINGHEI ST. and detail a guard.
C.O's. 5th. and 7th.Aust.Field Ambs. will deliver surplus material to the dump and obtain a receipt.

9. A certificate will be obtained from C.O. of relieving Unit that Stations are left in a Sanitary condition. These certificates will be forwarded to this office within 48 hours.
10. Handing over receipts in duplicate of stores and equipment handed over will be forwarded to this office within 48 hours of relief.
11. 4th. and 22nd. Dental Units will move with 5th. Aust. Field Amb. 24th. Dental Unit will report for duty to H.Q. 6th. Army A.F.A. Bde. Sheet 28 H.33.a.9.1. at 3 pm. 3th. November 1917.
