

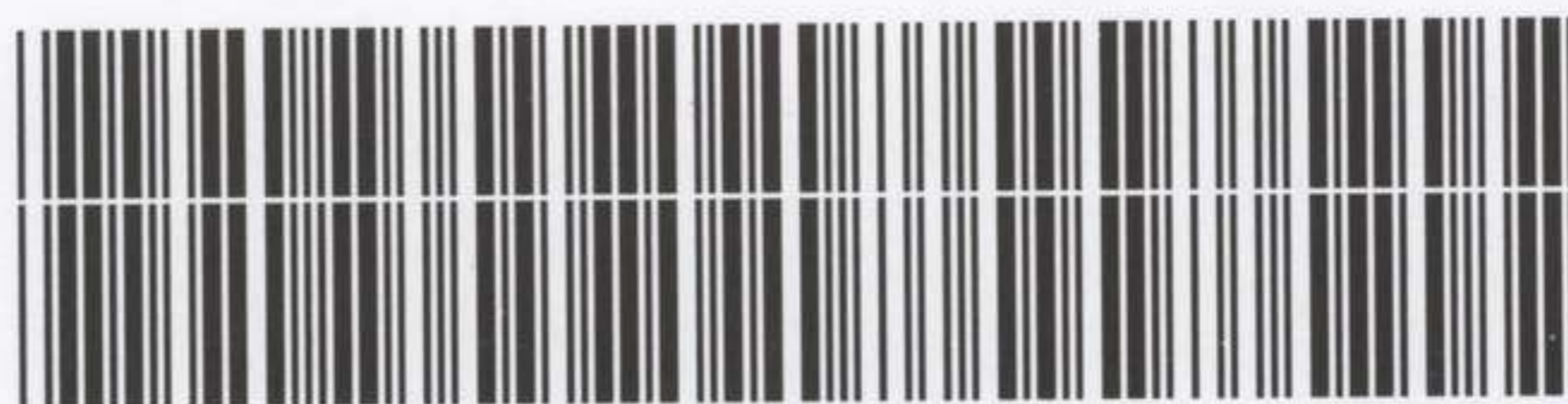

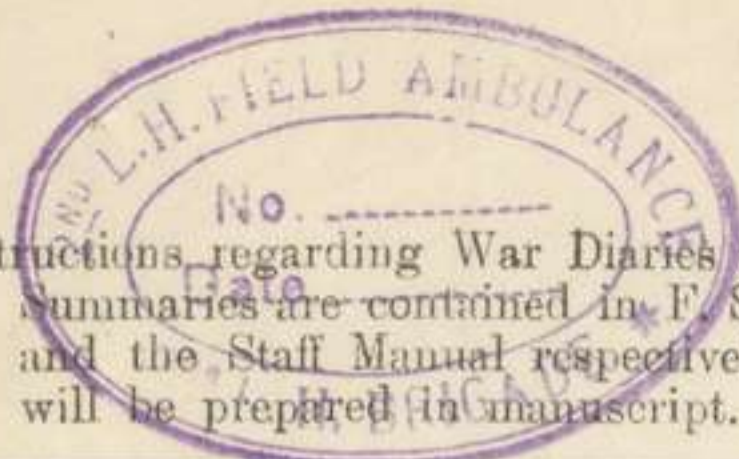

ES SALT	1/5/18	0030	<p>The march up No 7 road commenced about 0030. The track was very rough and steep so progress was necessarily very slow with the camels, also the atmosphere was very oppressive. We reached the plateau at 0400 just as it was getting light. During the night we had constantly to change the packs on to cacaolet camels, causing much delay. We joined up with Brigade at 0630 at a point on the road one and a half miles SW of ES SALT and barracked the camels and off saddled and had breakfast. An order came from Brigade to be ready to move on at 0715. It now commenced to rain. We moved off in rear of Brigade at 0900, taking about one and a half hours to reach the top of the hill overlooking ES SALT, — owing to the steep and rough nature of the track. Here an order came back to remain where we were till fine weather, so I went down to ES SALT to find who had sent the order and found it was the Brigade. I went back and moved the Ambulance down by a fairly good track about 1200. The rain ceased at 1100. The Ambulance moved out along the AMMAN ROAD and halted at (J 21 ES-SALT 2nd edition) and I went on to find the Brigade. Found them at (O 21 ES-SALT 2nd edition) and that the 5th L.H. Regiment were to attack a ridge at once, so sent back for the cacaolet camels to come out at once, the tent division to follow slowly. There were no casualties and just after the cacaolet camels arrived, an order came to withdraw back through</p>	prints

	1/5/18		ES SALT, so I sent the caicolet camels back with orders to turn the tent division back and wait for the Brigade at (J 21 ESSALT 2 nd edition) The ambulance joined in behind the Brigade at 2400 and proceeded along the road towards ES SALT.	JRMB
	2/5/18	0700 1000	The Brigade passed by ES SALT and eventually came to a halt on the SHUNET NIMRIN ROAD with the ambulance about one mile from ES SALT. It was raining again and very misty. Here we remained till 0700 and moved on about 200 yards, halting again. At 1000 word came back that the Brigade was to attack dismounted so a dressing station was formed where we were and six dismounted bearers and the caicolet camels were taken to (L 8 ES-SALT 2 nd edition). The attack did not materialise. At 1400 orders came to get back to the horses and prepare to move out along the AMMAN road again. We moved out behind the Brigade. The ambulance took up a well-sheltered position at (J 27 ESSALT 2 nd edition) being about the centre of the Brigade position. We off-saddled and took the packs off the camels. Had our first sleep since leaving the JORDAN.	JRMB

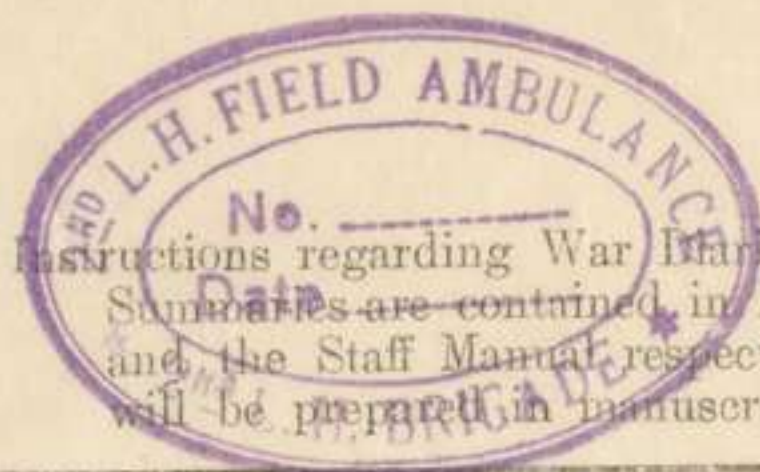

"	11/5/18		Major Bowman and Pte Evans JO. and 2 R.H. rejoined at D.H.Q. Pte Wauhope JA. NO 17852, NO 7 Sanitary Sectn. detached to his unit. Camped as above. One Sandcart + 1 L.P. waggon were detached to 6th L.H. Regt. which moved out to WADI AUJA. Pte Hobart R. evacuated sick 28/4/18. Unit moved with Brigade from WADI KELT to a camp site along BEISAN ROAD transcampsite [PALESTINE SHEET XVIII Sq. H 36]. The weather during the move was very hot windy and dusty. 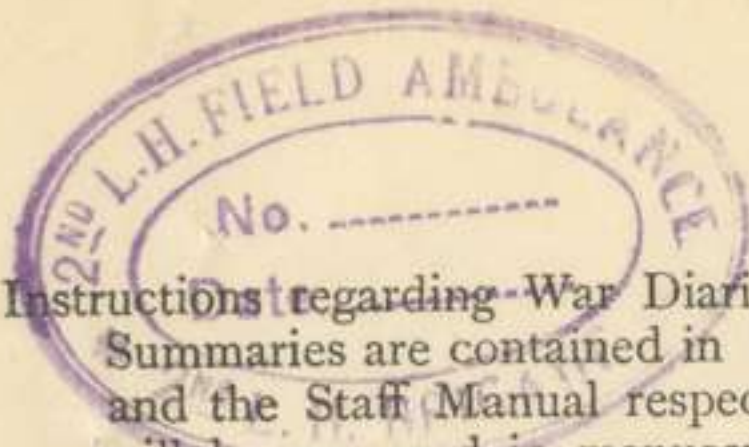

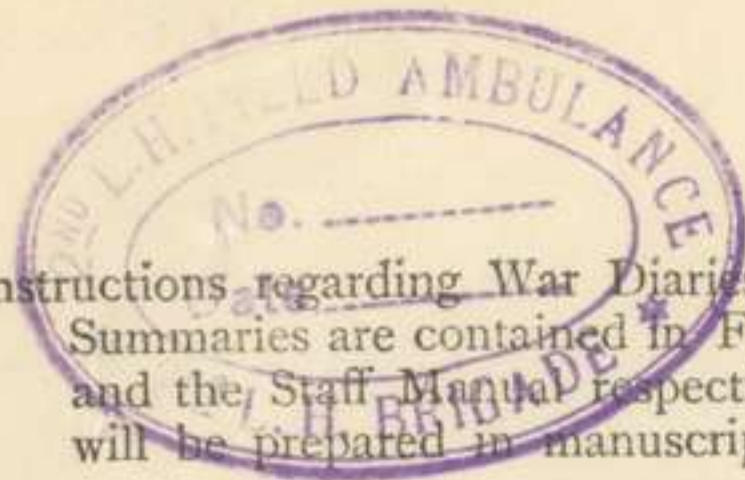
