28 Aug	Fatih	Cts Henderson & Co reported to C Sgdn for duty.
29	<del>Waly</del>	1020 supplied outposts.
30	<del>Waly</del>	Inspection + report on roads between Fatih + Opkatura.
31	<del>Waly</del>	107th Heavy Regiment, mail arrived. Brigades inspected Rgt at 1630.
1 Sep	<del>Waly</del>	Gen Chevill inspected Camp. Taube flew over Had.
2		Col Todd Dye Sgdn + 2 <sup>nd</sup> in Command inspected front line posts. Bada Abt + Haska
3	<del>Waly</del>	Parade Capt Collick tendered dinner by Rgt. on eve of departure for France. Rgt left Fatih 0530 for front line. A Sgdn Abt B + HQ Bada C Sgdn to Haska
4 to 14	Bada <del>Waly</del>	Main work Patrols & Reconnoitering, Paties. Remnants arrived on 8 inst.
15	<del>Waly</del>	Rgt assembled + moved out on bank of Byade to Salmana arriving 0830. bivouaced until 0700, water + feet horses.
17	Salmana <del>Waly</del>	Plains covered over Troops all day, also Taube. One man killed by m.g. fire from Taube. 1800 Brigade moved out en route for Mazar arrived
18	Mazar <del>Waly</del>	0600 18 <sup>th</sup> attack not hindered heavy troops returned at 1015. 1030 Brigade moved + moved off to Salmana, water $\frac{2}{3}$ return journey.
