31.8.15	AGHYL DERE	1800	Gun Section rejoined regiment and in evening relieved all gun section in trenches. No of men in trenches reduced to twenty five.
2.9.15		2000	Gun section returned to B.H.Q.s which have been established at TABLE TOP.
8.9.15	TABLE TOP	2200	Regt less one ofr and twelve men left in trenches at AGHYL DERE marched out from bivouacs to TABLE TOP and bivouaced on CANTERBURY SLOPE.
9.9.15			Regt acting as duty regiment to Bde till further orders. Ofr and men returned from AGHYL DERE.
11.9.15			LIEUT OLIVER returned to duty.
