



G.S. 1428.

1. It is important that, during the period of the Armistice and the subsequent period of demobilization, educational facilities should be offered to all ranks.

2. The objects to be aimed at are :-

- (a) To broaden the view, to quicken the intelligence, and to create a desire for study.
- (b) To help men in their work after the war by practical instruction in the trade or profession they will follow.

3. Steps should be taken to attain the results stated in 2(a) without delay.

The practical instruction mentioned in 2(b) will require careful organization and arrangement, and an enquiry into the facilities available.

4. As regards general education, the steps to be taken are :-

- (a) To discover instructors and, if necessary, to give them a short course of training.
- (b) To inaugurate a series of lectures on general subjects. These should be given to battalions, companies, or similar units, as part of the daily training.
- (c) To start a series of classes in certain subjects. These classes will be voluntary, but men who take them up will be required to complete the series.

5. Provided instructors are available, the following general subjects, among others, are suggested for treatment, as part of the daily training.

- (a) History of the British Empire, and how it came to be formed.
- (b) Geographical features and conditions in the various parts of the Empire.
- (c) The countries which have formed the various theatres of operations, and accounts of these operations.
- (d) The History of Allied Countries.
- (e) The part played by the Navy.
- (f) The development of Aircraft.
- (g) The world shortage of material, and the importance of salvage.

6. Classes, as stated in 4(c), should be held in the following subjects :-

- (a) Languages, as far as instructors will permit.
- (b) English Literature.
- (c) History.
- (d) Reading and writing.
- (e) Arithmetic.
- (f) Elementary Mathematics.
- (g) Advanced Mathematics.
- (h) Freehand drawing.
- (i) Topography.
- (j) Shorthand.
- (k) Veterinary science.
- (l) Ambulance work.
- (m) Physical Training (to train instructors).

7. The above subjects are given as a guide only, and should be added to as facilities and the presence of instructors permit.

8. The facilities for the practical instruction mentioned in 2(b) are being enquired into.

9. In Corps and Divisions a General Staff Officer will be detailed to superintend this training. Special Officers will be appointed in Brigades, Battalions, and similar units. They will be struck off duty for this purpose. Instructors will be struck off duty as may be found necessary.

10. The joining of classes will be voluntary, but when men have been relieved of duty in order to attend absence will be treated as a breach of discipline.

11. It is probable that a greater number of instructors will be found in some formations than in others. Instructors should therefore be pooled in the various districts, such as CAIRO, ALEXANDRIA, and KANTARA.

12. Instructions are being given to the Stationery Department to issue such stationery as is available for educational purposes.

13. The War Office will be asked to provide text-books, but formations should state their requirements, and, as far as possible, local supplies will be made available.

14. It will be brought to the notice of all lectures and instructors that, when dealing with questions open controversy, their task is to state facts, and not to express their personal opinions.

15. Corps, Palestine L. of C., Force in Egypt, and independant formations will forward any suggestions they have to make from time to time.

16. Instructions for Indian troops will be issued separately.

7. with the exception of baggage guards detailed in para 1 above, all other troops of the Division will march with the column.

8. Tentage and camp equipment will be taken from this area. All baggage not required on the march will be sent by rail under guards mentioned in para 6 above. The approximate weight of rail borne baggage will be wired to this H.Q. before 2000 to-day. Transport will be provided under arrangements to be made by this H.Q. for the conveyance of baggage from present camp sites to loading points to TELSHAH (x)

9. One day's supplies and unexpended portions of current day's plus iron ration, will be carried on thirty day's march. One day's supplies will be drawn at KENDALL, GAZA, and BILAH.

10. O.C. Field Squadron will arrange with D.D.W. for water at YEMMAH and KENDALL, and with Staff Officer Water, GAZA, for water at GAZA, BILAH and RAFA.

11. Each formation and unit will detail a representative native to proceed ahead with a Staff Officer detailed by this H.Q., to be allotted camp sites. Formations and units will be notified by wire of time and place representative will report to Staff Officer.

12. The Divisional Claims Officer will arrange with Military Governor JAFFA to hand over all billets occupied by the Division, to stand, adjust any claims. Claims will be forwarded to Central Claims Bureau, GAZA, during a period of time to be determined by the Divisional Headquarters.

13. Divisional Headquarters will march at the head of the column.

5. The General Officers Commanding 1st L.H.Bde. and N.Z.M.R. Bde will each detail one officer to accompany the personnel attending the course. The officers detailed should, if possible be interested in agriculture. As the number of instructors who speak English is limited, it is considered that if the officers detailed have a knowledge of French it would be of great assistance to the personnel attending the course.

6. The senior officer accompanying the personnel attending the course will be directly responsible to this H.Q. for the discipline etc., of the whole Divisional party whilst attending the Agricultural College.

7. Formations and units will be notified of the officer in charge of the Divisional party, to whom all parties will report at the Agricultural College at 1030 on Monday 16th December.

8. It is to be impressed on the personnel attending the course that this is a privilege extended to this Division only. All Commanders will ensure that only well behaved men are selected to attend the course.
