Information 1. (a) On 'Z' Day at zero hour the Army is taking the offensive, pivoting on its positions in the Jordan Valley (CHAYRON's FORCE), attacking on the front between the high ground East of EL MUGHEIR (113.Q.5) and the Sea with the object of inflicting a decisive defeat on the enemy and driving him from the line NABLUS - SAMARIA - TUL KERAM - CAESAREA.

(b) The XXIst Corps, with 5th A.L.H. Brigade, 60th Division, and French Detachment, are to drive the enemy from the line DELA SHARAF - SAMARIA - TUL KERAM.

(c) The XIXth Corps are attacking astride the NABLUS road to gain the high ground North and North-east of NABLUS.

Intention. 2. The Task of the Desert Mounted Corps (less A.A.N.Z. mounted Division) is to advance to EL ARULEH - BEISAN, cut the enemy's railway communications at their most vital point, and get in a position to strike the enemy's columns if they endeavour to escape in a Northerly or North-easterly direction.

Orders to Troops. 3. In consequence the Corps will move on 'Z' Day with the above object in view as follows :-

(a) (i) The 5th Cavalry Division (plus 12th L.A.M. Battery and No. 7 Light Car Patrol, less 2 gun cars) to be in a Position of Readiness in rear of the 60th Division by 5 a.m.

(ii) The 4th Cavalry Division (plus 11th L.A.M. Battery and No. 1 Light Car Patrol) to be in rear of 7th (Indian) Division by 6 a.m.

(iii) Australian Mounted Division to be in the SARONA area vacated by 4th Cavalry Division by 7 a.m.

(b) When the XXIst Corps have opened the way for crossing the Nahr FALIK and Kh. EZ ZERKUYEH Marsh :-

(i) 5th Cavalry Division (plus 12th L.A.M. Battery and No. 7 L.C. Patrol, less 2 gun cars) will advance on:

1st Objective, the line TELL ADA DHRUR (exclusive) - HUDEIRA - the Sea, securing in the first place the crossings over the W. ISKAIDERUNIEH.

Thence moving with utmost speed to a position North of EL ARULEH by the HUDEIRA - EZ ZERGHANIYEH - KH EG SHRAH - ABU SHUSHEH Road.

Touch must be maintained with the 4th Cavalry Division on its right.

Should any portion of the enemy's force retreat in the direction of HAIFA, only sufficient troops to keep touch with them and protect the line of communication should be detached.

The passage of the remainder of the Corps through the MUSMUS Defile must be protected from the North by a detachment left in the neighbourhood of JARRAK for this purpose. This detachment will not be recalled without reference to the Corps.

In advancing on the EL AFULEH road the HAIFA railway should be cut and dispositions should ensure a detachment visiting HAZEREM, with a view to capturing influential prisoners and important documents.

The Division will be prepared to operate towards JENIN and BEISAN according to circumstances.

The conditions for the advance will be as laid down in the instructions issued under S.C. 920/11 of 12th September.

(ii) 4th Cavalry Division (plus 11th L.A.M. battery and No. 1 Light Car Patrol) will advance on its 1st Objective, the line NAKON - JELAMEH - TELL EDH DHUR (inclusive) keeping touch with the 5th Cavalry Division on its left.

The advance will be continued with the utmost speed via the JELAMEH - KH ES SUMRAH - EL LEIJUN Road to EL AFULEH. On no account will the Division be diverted from its objective by the presence of hostile troops in the TUL KERAM - KULUNSAWEH - EL TLAH area; these will be dealt with by the XXIst Corps.

The railways from EL AFULEH to JENIN, BEISAN, and HAIFA, will be cut as soon as possible.

On arrival at EL AFULEH a detachment will be sent to seize the roads and railway bridges over the JORDAN at JISR NEJAMEH moving via NEIN, ENDOR, STRAIN. The railway bridge at JISR NEJAMEH will be prepared for demolition but will not be destroyed so long as it can be held.

From AFULEH the advance will continue as early as possible on BEISAN with a view to closing the roads converging on that place from the JORDAN Valley and NATLUS.

The conditions for the initial advance will be as laid down in the instructions issued under S.C. 920/11 of 12th September.

To attain positions of better security the division would stand as follows - MAFJASHEH - ARDALAH and MAFJASHEH - JERICHO.

(iii) Australian mounted Division (less 5th A.L.m. Bde) will move across the AUJA into the position of readiness vacated by the 4th Cavalry Division directly that Division is clear.

Hence it will move to a position on or about the N. ISKANDERUNIEH on receipt of orders from Corps Headquarters; thence follow the remainder of the Corps.

It will be prepared to send a detachment of one brigade or less from EL LEJJUN to block the roads and railway passing through JENIN and to gain touch with the 5th A.L.m. brigade, which is to rejoin the Division in this area.

(iv) R.h.A. Directly the initial barrage under which the infantry advance and which commences at an hour known as "XXIst Corps Zero hour" is complete, the R.h.A. batteries will rejoin their divisions under divisional arrangements, after reference to G.O.C. R.A., XXIst Corps.

Dividing Line.

4. The Dividing Line between 4th and 5th Cavalry Divisions will be TABSOR - EL MUGHAIIR - TELL EDH DHUR - KENNIR - KSFREIN - DUZEILEH.

Demolitions.

5. Demolitions on railways should be limited to such as can be easily repaired.

Naval Cooperation.

6. Torpedo Boat destroyers are cooperating in the attack and later in the advance of this Corps along the Coast. Care must be taken to display the Red and Yellow Troop Flags as prominently as possible for the information of the Navy.

Roads.

7. Allotment of Roads. The TABSOR - HUDEIRA Road and route along the Beach is allotted to this Corps when required. If 4th and 5th Cavalry Divisions both cross the W. FALIK by the beach and coast road, the following roads are allotted after the W. FALIK is crossed:-

(a) 4th Cavalry Division - TABSOR - EL MUGHAIIR - ZELIFEH road crossing the ISKANDERUNIEH at KH ES SH MUKAMED in G.19.b.central, branching off the main road at P.1.C. central or G.25.c.2.2.

(b) 5th Cavalry Division - TABSOR - LUKNALID - HUDEIRA Road crossing the ISKANDERUNIEH by bridges in F.30.b.central.

(c) Australian Mounted Division - TABSOR - EL MUGHAIIR - ZELIFEH road, crossing the ISKANDERUNIEH by bridges in F.30.b.central.

An additional bridge over the NAHR FALIK is being constructed by the XXIst Corps for the use of the Desert mounted Corps.

The troops of XXIst Corps have precedence over the existing bridge at (D3) N.6.c.9.3. Desert mounted Corps train and park have precedence over XXIst Corps trains and parks on all roads on "Z" day.

(This section will follow the 5th Cavalry Division along the coastal road, it will follow immediately behind the fighting troops, the transport of 5th Cavalry Division giving way and keeping clear of the roads.

Instructions. 10. Instructions regarding A.A.F., Communications, Medical, Administrative and Supply Services, Traffic Control and Prisoners, Ammunition supply, Engineer Arrangements are being issued separately.

Time. 11. Watches will be synchronised daily, commencing from receipt of this order, by the time received by wireless from C.H.Q. every day at 0815 and 1800.

12. The date of 'Z' day and Zero hour will be communicated verbally to those concerned.

Reports. 13. Reports to Advanced Corps Headquarters at Pt. 121 in Z.27.b.4.7.on 'Z' day until it moves forward. Advanced Report Centres will be communicated.

Arrangements with R.A.F.

1. For the forthcoming operations two flights of 142nd Squadron (12 machines), under Major MILLAR, will operate with Desert Mounted Corps. The remaining flight of R.A.F. will remain at JERUSALEM and operate independently with Chaytor's force in the JORDAN VALLEY.

2. Position of Corps Headquarters and Squadrons. Prior to advance, No. 142 Squadron less detached flight will be at SARONA Aerodrome. As Desert Mounted Corps Headquarters move forward, landing grounds if obtainable will be used by the Squadron.

The supply of petrol and oil by air will be undertaken by one flight of 142nd Squadron to keep the machines working until road communications become possible.

3. Liaison Officer. A senior R.A.F. officer will accompany Desert Mounted Corps and take charge of all R.A.F. matters during operations. He will be accompanied by an R.A.F. Orderly Officer, who will be responsible for the proper manipulation of message gathering apparatus and the selection of forward landing grounds.

4. Corps Intelligence Officer with Squadron. Capt. LLEWELLYN, at present Intelligence Officer with the detached flight at JERUSALEM, will hand over there to an officer selected by Major-General MAYOR, A.C.M.Z. Mounted Division.

5. System of Communications. Direct telephone between Desert Mounted Corps and No. 142 Squadron at SARONA until advance of Corps H.Q. Telephone communication will be kept up if possible as the advance continues. If telephone communication breaks down, wireless to be used with Operation Order 1010. 3 kilo set will be at Squadron headquarters.

TWO sets of Apparatus for picking up messages will be at Corps H.Q., and will be put up by the Corps under directions of R.A.F. Officer.

6. Photography and Artillery. Artillery Co-operation and Photography will not be undertaken by No. 142 Squadron.

7. Special Bombing. All special bombing will be done by C.R.Q. on application through Corps Liaison Officer.

8. Protection of Landing Grounds. On reaching JANIN and AFULEH the hostile aerodromes and landing grounds will be kept clear of all traffic, and small guards placed in charge. The importance of this cannot be underestimated as JANIN and AFULEH are the only known landing grounds in that area and will be required by our R.A.F. as soon as possible.

9. Deficiencies of Ground Signals and Front Line Strips. Deficiencies in units' or command signals in front line strips are to be made up at once, and a certificate to this effect has already been applied for from units.

Units will report whether they are in possession of message pads for use with the Popham Panel.

DESERET MOUNTED CORPS. Engineer Arrangements.

1. SELMEH - SARONA - SUMAIL Bivouac Area.

Bivouac Areas have been arranged as follows :-
West of SELMEH. Known as No. 1 Area and marked on the sunprints already issued to Divisions.

Area Z.19.c.&d. - Z.25 - J.1 - Y.24.a, c.&d. - Y.30 - H.6.
Known as SUMAIL Area.

Water arrangements in conjunction with a Water Officer appointed by the D.D.W., P.L. of C., and in communication with General Staff, Divisions, is being arranged by the Acting Field Engineer, Desert mounted Corps.

The L.I. of C. will cut entrances and exits where required and arrange for water, but no actual work will be commenced until Z - 4.

2. Bridges. A table of sizes need over the AUJA river are as follows :-

FERREKHTYE (Known as BALLS BRIDGE) 60 pounders.

CASTLE BRIDGES (a) Trestle 60 pounders.
(b) Barrels 60 pounders.

Near dam at JERISHEH. Pontoon Bridge to be } 18 pounders only.
erected by "D" Troop.

HADRAH Bridges. (a) Trestle Tractors.
(b) Stone 60 pounders.

JERISHEH Pontoon Bridge being erected
by XXIst Corps. 18 pounders only.

YELLOW HOUSE Bridges (a) Trestle 60 pounders.
(b) Barrels 60 pounders.

SUMAIL Bridge Trestle 60 pounders

Flags and notice boards have been prepared for Divisions.

3. Explosives.

A special "Corps" demolition party, with the 4th Cavalry Division has been equipped on pack animals with explosives sufficient to prepare for demolition two piers of a masonry railway bridge and cause a gap of 80 - 100 feet.

The special party carries also explosives for demolition of a single arched bridge.

Each division is in addition being equipped with sufficient explosives to destroy 4 kilos of railway line and a reserve sufficient for the demolition of a substantial one-arched bridge.

4. Water. - North of AUJA river.

Along the coast between ARSUF and JELIL are a large number of shallow wells 4 feet to 5 feet from surface, capable of giving 15,000 gallons an hour.

At JELIL water is pumped across into valley about X.9 location. Supply 150,000 gallons per diem provided Infantry have moved out.

Along AUJA River water can be pumped into troughs almost anywhere.

Chursas are available for use further North.

Three engines and pumps are held in reserve at SARONA.

5. Roads and Rivers.

Coarse wire netting, split timbers, billhooks, etc., are to be carried for help in negotiating swampy places.

In place of the steel boats carried by "D" Troop it is proposed to carry a trestle bridge specially designed for quick erection.

It is proposed that the 13th Pontoon Park R.E., should carry sufficient pontoons and sufficient Weldon Trestles to form a bridge of each over a span of 50 feet at the ISKANDERUNEH.

6. mobile Park.

Arrangements have been made to stock a mobile R.E. Park on as many lorries as can be made available.

The stores carried will comprise water gear, timber, and materials for repair of bridges, wire road material, spares for enemy pump installations, &c.

Defence material is earmarked at SARONA, but owing to weight cannot be carried forward.

7. Detailed instructions to Field Squadron Commanders will be issued by C.R.E., Desert Mounted Corps.

DESERT MOUNTED CORPS.Instructions regarding Prisoners of War.

1. The following instructions are issued in amplification of this office I.62/4 of March 7th 1918.

The object of mounted troops should be to rid themselves of prisoners at the earliest possible moment. Even at Divisional Headquarters the situation changes so rapidly as to render it unlikely that prisoners will give any information of tactical value, other than that afforded by their identifications. It must also be borne in mind that the G.S.O. 3 has other duties to perform, at least as important as the supervision of interrogation. Consequently evacuation should not be delayed for purposes of interrogation, except in very special cases.

2. (a) It will therefore be the business of Intelligence Officers at Divisions to see that they get access to prisoners before evacuation, to obtain information on points of immediate interest from a selected few, so as not to delay evacuation in any way.

(b) A form is attached showing the points on which such immediate information should be sought. This is a guide only, and it will depend on Intelligence Officers to ensure that, while time is not wasted in threshing out details of no importance, or collecting information on facts already well established, nothing of real interest, viz:- a new identification or news of reinforcements or intentions, etc., is overlooked.

(c) Divisional I.O.'s will telegraph a precis of information gained from preliminary interrogations to Corps Headquarters., repeating to G.S.I., G.H.Q.

(d) A prisoner who has given, or is likely to give, good information will be labelled. Labels for this purpose are being supplied.

3. Documents.

(a) Prisoners will be searched as soon as they reach the Divisional Collecting Station or Field Ambulance, or Medical Unit, but not before. As regards search, the same procedure will be carried out for wounded as for unwounded prisoners.

(b) Escorts are responsible that documents are not destroyed by prisoners under their charge, or taken by unauthorised persons. They are not allowed to take away documents or effects except when they have reason to suspect prisoners of intending to destroy them. In such a case the articles taken away will be handed in at the Divisional Collecting Station, Field Ambulance, or Medical Unit.

(c) Prisoners pay-books and "tezkeres" (a large document like a share certificate) should not be taken from them in any circumstances. Intelligence Officers should be able to recognise these.

(d) The examination of documents at Divisional Headquarters should be cursory only, after which they should be done up into bundles, sandbags, or other convenient parcels

and forwarded to G.S. "I", G.H.Q., by the first available means. Easily recognisable labels, addressed to G.S. "I", G.H.Q., are being provided for this. Isolated papers appearing to be of immediate importance (orders, marked maps, &c.) should be sent by D.R.L.S.

(e) A special staff is being kept at G.H.Q. for deciphering captured documents. In the past information of real value, and having an immediate bearing on operations, has been lost owing to failure to get captured documents examined early, and the importance of getting them back quickly should be impressed on all concerned.

4. All N.C.O.s. in charge of prisoners will be in possession of a memo showing the total number of officers or other ranks, place of capture, and division by which captured. This will be handed over to U.C., Collecting Station.

5. Prisoners taken by Desert Mounted Corps will be as a rule handed over to the nearest infantry which can receive them, who will be responsible for escorting them to Corps Compounds. It must however be clearly understood that they will in all cases be passed through divisional collecting stations, and never handed over independently to infantry/Brigades and Regiments.

A receipt will invariably be taken from Infantry formation
for prisoners handed over to them.

6. Detailed instructions regarding disposal of prisoners will be issued by A.P.M. Desert Mounted Corps to Divisional A.P.Ms.

1. Telegraph and telephone. Z day. Advanced Corps Headquarters at JANISHEH.

A single cable will be laid behind the 4th and 5th Cavalry Divisions as they move forward.

No cable communication will be maintained with the Australian Mounted Division while moving forward.

Signal Offices will be established on the cable laid behind the 4th Cavalry Division at the following points:-
(i) MOBILE station. On head of 4th Cavalry Division.
(ii) S.22.a. (Sheet D3) below VILLEQOTY and
(iii) MELLAUGHAIN, junction of Regal et al.

As Advanced Desert Corps moves forward, it will be able to make use of these sub-offices for telegraph communication only, to the 4th and 5th Cavalry Divisions.

Divisions will keep touch with the cable wagon laying behind them, by means of despatch riders.

Sub-offices (i) and (ii) will close and move forward with Advanced Corps Headquarters. Sub-office (iii) will remain until the overhead wires are put through by G.H.Q. Signals to Advanced Corps Headquarters.

Advanced Corps Headquarters at F.30.b. (Sheet D3).

All three Divisions will be in cable communication with Advanced Corps headquarters.

Z + 1 day. (a) Advanced Corps Headquarters at F.30.b. (Sheet D3).

The 4th and 5th Cavalry Divisions, and the Australian Division if necessary, will be followed as before by a single cable. Every advantage will be taken of the existing Turkish lines following the routes of the Divisions, in order to save cable.

A Signal sub-office and test office will be established at KERKUR where a number of existing Turkish wires meet together. This office will be available for communication to Divisions when Advanced Corps headquarters moves forward.

(b) Advanced Corps Headquarters at EL LEJJUN.

All cables or existing Turkish wires which are being used to Divisions will be lead in to the Advanced Corps Headquarters here.

A party from Corps Signals will be sent forward to AFULEH to establish a test office there and connect the Turkish wires through from Divisions to the Corps Headquarters.

Z + 2 and following days. Advanced Corps H.Q. at EL LEJJUN.

It is hoped to be able to communicate with all three Divisions over the existing Turkish wires.

A diagram showing the Turkish wires reported to be existing in March 1918 is attached. (to Divisions only).

2. Wireless. All Divisions will erect their Wireless Stations whenever possible, even when the ground or airlines are working satisfactorily, and will get in touch with the Corps Wireless Station as promptly as possible.

Detailed instructions for wireless working will be given to HQ, Signals of Divisions.

3. Visual. A Visual Station will be established at Point 180 (X-10-a-5-9 Sheet C2) and always at Advanced Corps Headquarters. All divisions will get in touch with this Station as quickly as possible. All Cavalry Signal Units will use this means of communication to its fullest extent, reserving their cable as much as possible.

4. Despatch Riders. Motor Cyclists will be used whenever possible in daytime. They will be replaced by mounted men over rough country and for night work. During the night, mounted Despatch Riders should be sent in pairs.

5. Pigeons. 10 Carrier Pigeons from C.H.Q. loft will be supplied to each Division on Z - 1 day and 10 Carrier Pigeons will be retained at Advanced Corps Headquarters. These birds must be liberated not later than 4 days after receipt, and must be properly watered and fed.

It is hoped to maintain a daily supply of 10 birds to each Division.

6. Relays. On Z Day, One troop of Cavalry will form a relay system from Advanced Corps n.Q. at JEISHEH along the road followed by the 4th Cavalry Division.

Posts will be established at EL JELIL Station, at Sub-office S.22.a. (Sheet D3), at EL MUGHAI'R, at the east bridge over the NAHR ISKANDEUR (which will be the terminal post) and at approximately every two miles between these points.

The 5th Cavalry Division will send their messages to the nearest post on the ralay.

All messages to be sent by relay must have the speed required marked on the envelope, viz., trot, canter, or gallop.

When Advanced Corps H.Q. moves forward, all these posts will be collected up and brought forward to the new Advanced Corps H.Q., except the post at EL MUGHAIL, which will remain until the sub-office there closes.

On Z + 1 and succeeding days the relay troop will be employed as found necessary.

7. Aeroplane Contact Patrol Communication. All units will carry the necessary apparatus for communicating to aircraft, which will be set out and worked promptly whenever required.

8. Technical instructions will be issued by A.D.A.S. Desert Mounted Corps to Signal Squadron Commanders.

Communications to Flank and Rear.

1. Telegraph and Telephone.

Z day. (a) Advanced Corps headquarters at JERICHEH. Telegraph and Telephone over existing permanent lines to Rear Corps H.Q., and G.n.Q.
(Sheet D3). (b) Advanced Corps Headquarters at F.30.b.

To Rear Corps H.Q. over one of the two cables laid from JERICHEH behind the Divisions.

To the XXIst Corps over the second of these two cables.

G.n.Q. Signal Company will lay a single cable forward with the move of Advanced Corps H.Q. from JERICHEH to F.30.b., which will be connected to lines working back to G.n.Q.

Z + 1 and following days. Advanced Corps H.Q. at EL QASR LEJJUN.

It is expected that overhead wires will be available direct from G.n.Q. to Advanced Corps H.Q., and communication to the Rear Corps H.Q. and 21st Corps will be obtained by this means.

It may also be possible to communicate with the 80th Division over existing Turkish wires.

2. Wireless. Will be used to G.n.Q., 21st Corps, 60th Divn., 142 Squadron R.A.F., and the Navy when required, and when communication by land line fails.

The Australian mounted Division will detach a Pack W/T Station to accompany their Brigade which will be attached to the 60th Division.

3. Visual. Communication will be obtained whenever possible from Advanced Corps H.Q. to 21st Corps, 60th Division, and the Navy.

4. Despatch Riders. As for Divisions.

5. Carrier Pigeons. All pigeons will fly back to G.n.Q. lofts and from there messages will be forwarded to the Addressees.

6. Relays. A troop of Cavalry will be employed by G.n.Q. Signals as guards to test points on their cables, and for purpose of relaying messages back from Advanced Corps H.Q. to G.n.Q.

7. Aeroplane Contact Patrol Communication. As for Divisions.

1. Each division will move with the whole of its Ammunition Column, both Light and Heavy. If necessity arises the Heavy portion of the Ammunition Columns of one or more divisions may be withdrawn and placed under Corps control.
2. A small dump of 100 rounds 13-pdr ammunition per gun and a certain amount of S.A.A. will be formed at CARRICK HILL (LEJJA sheet C.20). This can be obtained by horse transport, but probably would only be required should the TABOR operations be prolonged.
3. Motor lorries for the supply of ammunition will fill up at LUDD on Z - 1 day and move to SARONA, carrying 150 rounds per gun and 900,000 S.A.A.
4. As soon as the situation allows these lorries will move via KALKILLEH and SF FISSH to KAKON.
On arrival at KAKON, one half of these lorries will dump their ammunition and return to SARONA for replenishment, and continue working between these two places. The other half will remain filled and follow up the Corps as circumstances allow.
5. The remainder of the ammunition allotted to the Corps will be moved up from LUDD to Advanced railhead, and collected from there as soon as the dump at SARONA is exhausted.
6. The ammunition of the Column will therefore be distributed as follows :-

With units	...	450 rounds per gun.
In lorries	...	150 " "
CARRICK HILL	...	100 " "
SARONA	...	200 " "
LUDD	...	200 " "

The above figures are approximate only.

7. The possibility of bad roads and congestion of traffic may very likely delay lorries, but they should arrive at KAKON on Z + 3 day at latest. Prior to this date the supply of ammunition must be replenished by the heavy column from one of the Corps dumps, or from the lorries if met on the road.
8. Detailed instructions will be issued by G.O.C., R.A. Desert Mounted Corps to R.A.A. Brigade commanders.

DESERT MOUNTED CORPS.Medical Arrangements.

1. Ambulances. The mobile Section of each Ambulance will be with its Brigade. One Immobile Section in each Division will be available for use as a Divisional Collecting Station under Divisional arrangements. Two Immobile Sections from each Division will form a Receiving Station which will be controlled by the D.D.M.S. as soon as they open to receive patients, or as specified below.

Mobile Sections will have ambulance wagons, camel cacolets and light motor ambulances for the evacuation of patients.

2. Light motor Ambulances, of all Divisions will travel by the TABSOR Road, under Divisional arrangements.

3. A motor Ambulance Convoy will run between TUL KERAM and WILHELMIA as soon as the main road is open; it is under the orders of G.H.Q.

4. A Casualty Clearing Station will be at WILHELMIA.

5. Moves of Receiving Stations. Each Receiving Station will follow in rear of its Division. On reaching EL MUGHAIIR the 4th Cavalry Divisional Receiving Station will proceed to TUL KERAM and open to receive patients; it is hoped that it will be established by the evening of Z + 1 day.

The 5th Cavalry Divisional Receiving Station will push on via LIKTERA to KH ES SULRAH where it should be opened ready to receive patients by the evening of Z + 1 day.

The Australian Mounted Divisional Receiving Station will move to TUL KERAM where it should arrive on the morning of Z + 2 day. It will not open unless ordered.

Each of these receiving stations will come under the orders of the D.D.M.S. when they reach the above mentioned places.

Further moves will be according to circumstances.

6. Evacuation of Casualties. Any casualties sustained before crossing the NAHR EL FALIK will be handed over to Infantry Ambulances. Any occurring after this will be carried forward to be sent to the 4th Cavalry D.R.S. at TUL KERAM. It is expected that an ambulance of the 30th Division will be at TUL KERAM on Z evening; this will receive any patients that may arrive before the 4th Cavalry D.R.S. is established there.

On and after Z + 1 day patients will be evacuated by Divisions to the 4th Cavalry D.R.S. at TUL KERAM. Here they remain until the motor Ambulance Convoy arrives to evacuate them to the C.C.S. at WILHELMIA.

When the 5th Cavalry D.R.S. at KH. ES SULRAH is ready to receive patients divisions forward of this will move evacuate to this place. Two Ford cars from each Division will then be sent to this D.R.S. for the evacuation of serious cases to TUL KERAM and will remain attached to the 5th Cavalry D.R.S. Slight cases will be sent to the C.C.S. at WILHELMIA by returning empty motor lorries.

7. The Descorps Operations Unit, will be attached to and move with 4th Cavalry D.R.S. to TUL KERAM if the road is practicable for it and will open up. If the road is impracticable for it the operating car will return to WILHELMIA and move up the main road to TUL KERAM as soon as it is open.

"PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN IN CONCEALED BIVOUACS".

(issued by XXIst Corps).

The following instructions will be strictly complied with by all troops bivouacing in the XXIst Corps Area.

- (1). (a) No movement whatever will be carried out between 0430 and 1830, except where stated below. This includes movement within the camps themselves.
(b) The importance of complete concealment must be impressed upon all ranks, and it should be explained to them that it is in their own interests to prevent the enemy from detecting our movements whether from air or by direct observation.
(c) Special police will be mounted by all units to stop movement in concealed bivouacs during daylight. These men should be carefully selected. They will be provided with whistles and field glasses, and on the approach of a hostile or doubtful aeroplane, they will blow four blasts on the whistle.
- (2). All ration dumps will be kept within the bivouac areas.
- (3) Cooking will be done by means of solidified alcohol. No fires whatever are to be lit.
- (4) (a) The watering of horses by daylight will be done as far as possible by bucket and should, whenever possible, be completed between the hours of 1200 and 1400.
(b) In cases where horses have to be brought out of their concealment to be watered, a hard and fast rule must be observed that they are not to be out except between 1200 and 1400.
(c) The R.A.F., are arranging for aeroplanes to be in the air from 1200 to 1400 to keep off hostile aircraft as far as possible.
(d) Watering of horses may be carried out without restrictions under cover of darkness.
- (5) Every bivouac area has special routes leading in and out. These routes are the only ones to be used.
- (6) During the period in which movements of troops are being carried out no enemy aeroplanes are to be fired at on by troops in concealed bivouacs. Anti-aircraft protection will be afforded by R.A.F. fighting machines and A.A.Guns.
- (7) Visits of Staff Officers and despatch riders during daylight will be reduced to a minimum.
- (8) No lights that are not essential will be shown by night.

Traffic Control.

The A.P.C. Desert Mounted Corps will issue detailed instructions to S.A.P.C.s. regarding traffic control, paying particular attention to the following points :-

- (a) Entrances and exits to and from "The Position of Concentration".
- (b) All bridges over the river AJJAH used by the Corps (in consultation with A.P.C., XXIst Corps).
- (c) Crossings over the River SALIK used by the Corps (in consultation with A.P.C., XXIst Corps.)

It is essential that a crossing over the River SALIK should be kept clear for Advanced headquarters and also for Ambulances.

- (d) Crossings over the River ISANDEKHULIN where points should be established to direct transport of the 4th Cavalry Division on to the tracks eastwards from the main road allotted to this division. One of the bridges in F.S.O.b. central should be kept clear when required by Advanced headquarters and Ambulance convoys.

All traffic control of the above mentioned localities will be undertaken in the first instance by Divisional M.P. until relieved as soon as possible by Corps M.P.
