All packs. "A" Squadron - 77 rides. "B" Sqdn. - 41 rides. "C" Sqdn - 52 rides. Hdqtrs - 12 rides. In addition 2 spare rides per Squadron.

4. The commad of all troops in "F" & "G" Section will pass to the O.C incoming troops on the completion of the reliefs. Until such completion troops will remain under the command of the present C.Os.

5. During the relief the C.Os of the 9th A.L.H. Regt, loth A.L.H Regt, and Worcestor Yeo. will hand over to the C.Os 1st. and 2nd. Battn. B. W. I. Regts the following stores, documents, &c. relating to their respective sections.

(a) All area stores for which receipts will be taken in triplicate.

(b) All special maps, sketches, orders and information relating to the defences.

6. Os., A.B & C Squadrons will each detail 1 NCO & 9 o/rs. to remain in each of the named posts as close support to the infantry. This personnel will be under the command of the Officers in charge of the respective posts for tactical purposes.
