- Patients for Hospital. 15. All Infectious and Venereal cases will be sent to 2nd. L.H. Field Ambulance. All other cases to N.Z.M.R. Field Ambulance.  
Patients for transfer to Cairo. Ambulances evacuating patients to Cairo will notify A.D.M.S. by 1200 of number and whether Imperial, Australian or New Zealand troops
- Sanitation. 16. Attention is drawn to D.R.O. NO25. para 87 dated 13/4/16.
