

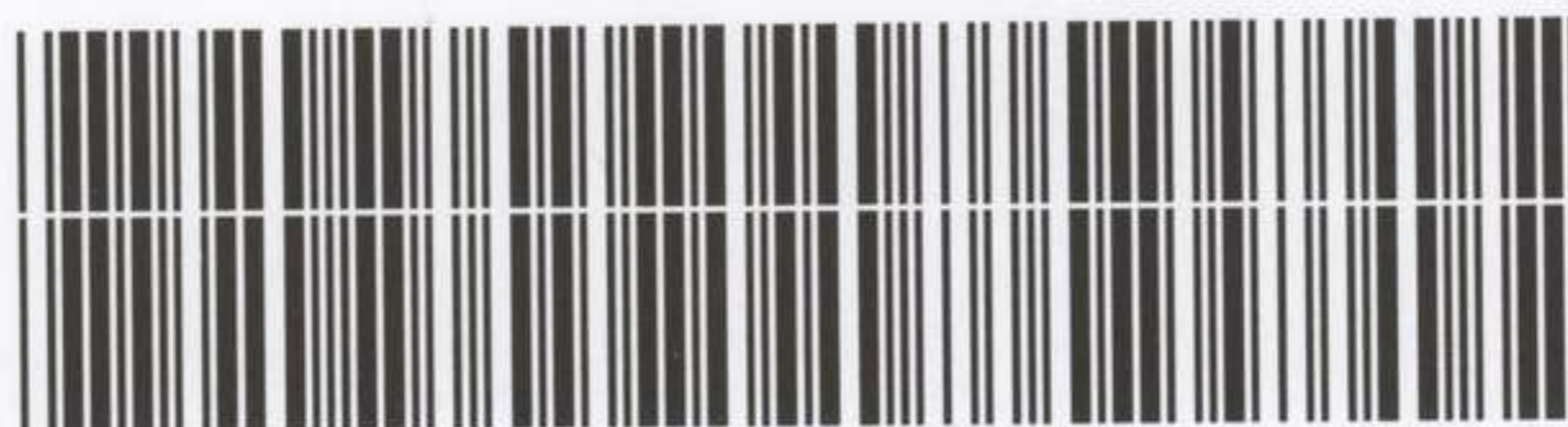

	24-11-16		Mobile Section left Khirba at 0645 & reached Salmana at 1500. 3 Sand Carts obtained from D.A.D.O.S. A.M.D. Bir-el-Abd. 16 Bamboo stretchers obtained from N.2. Mt'd Hd. Amb. Bir-el-Abd. 1 officer (Capt Guille) & 10 O.Ks (of Immobile Section at Et Maler) & part of equipment proceeded by train from Romani to Mazaar & commenced to establish a Clearing Hospital there. 2 O.Ks returned to Immobile Section from Kit Bag Stores Ghezireh
