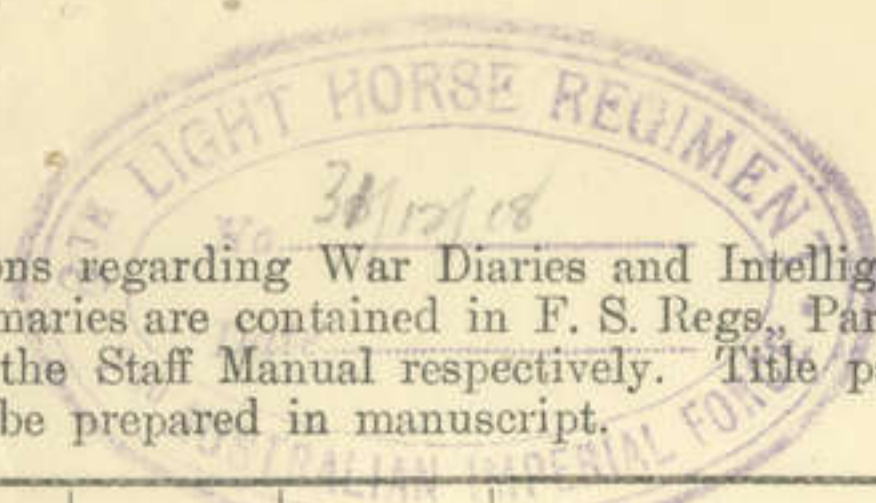

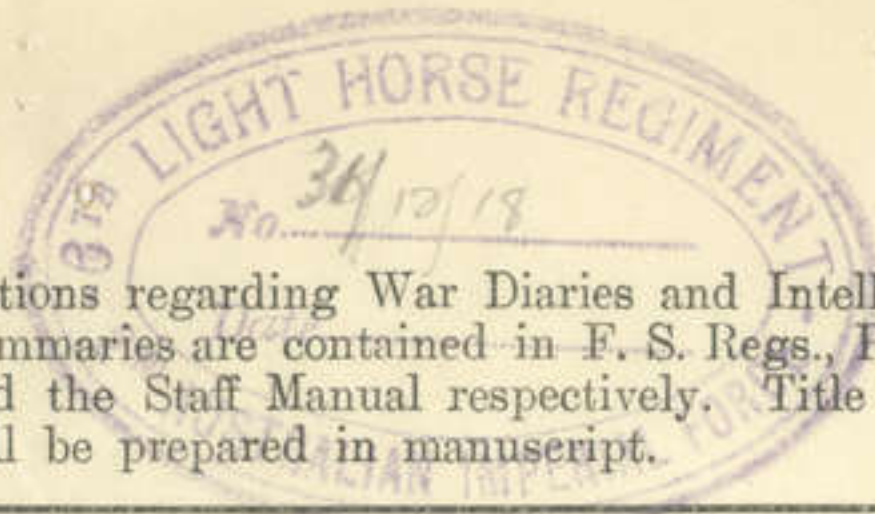

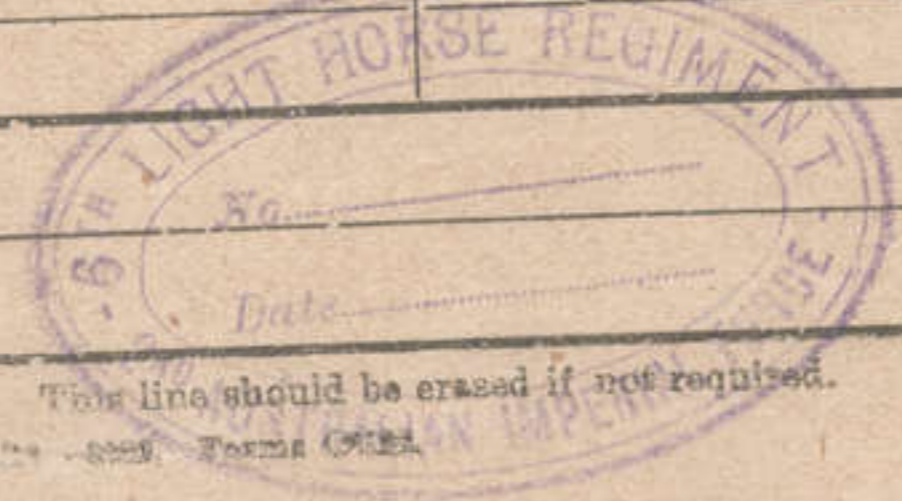

3. Starting Point :- Metal road near B.H.Q. at 0925. Units will be formed up at this point by 0910. Regiment will be formed up in mass on flat near Y.M.C.A. facing West by 0845 to-morrow 18/12/18. Parafe States to be handed into Orderly Room by 0700 to-morrow morning.

4. March Discipline. As divisions with guns and ~~xxxxxx~~ transports will be on the road marched tables must be adhered to and strict march discipline maintained.

5. Rations. The Regiment will march out with one iron ration, 24 hours mobile ration, and will therefore be rationed up to and including breakfast 20th.inst plus iron rations. Rations will not be drawn again after 17th.inst. until the Brigade reaches MEJDEL, ~~xxx~~ and will thereafter be drawn at each stage.

6. Transport, All transport will asemble on flat East of B.H.Q. at 0830 on 18th.Inst. and will there come under the Orders of Lieut Campbell 6th.L.H.Regiment. Transport will proceed by Westerly (main) road to YEBNAH. Vehicles should be lightly loaded

7. Camp Sites. R.Q.M.S. will accompany Staff Captain leaving B.H.Q. 0830. on 18th.Inst. to be shown camp sites & Water Area. He will accompany Staff Captain ~~dx~~ daily moving off 1 hour before Brigade On the days on which rations are drawn Q.M. & the usual parties will also be sent ahead O.C.Squadrons must see that all camp sites on route are left in a clean and sanitary condition. rubbish and tins must be burnt, not buried.
